

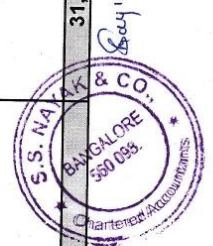

ABOUT ABHIVRUDDI (SOCIETY FOR SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT)

ABHIVRUDDI is a Non-Governmental Development Organization established in the year 1992 under the Karnataka State Societies Registration Act 1960. The focus of ABHIVRUDDI is towards importance of education for children, women empowerment, capacity building, and social movements to improve socio economic condition of rural poor community, men and women folks. Natural resource development in resource fragile rain fed areas to improve the livelihood status. Skill development and to initiate various socio economic educational, health, entre-partnership development, women empowerment, trainings and micro credit management with the active participation of community based organizations through participatory approach.

v. MISSION STATEMENT

THE MISSION OF THE ORGANIZATION IS TO PROMOTE SUSTAINABLE RURAL DEVELOPMENT THROUGH APPROPRIATE DEVELOPMENT INTERVENTIONS BASED ON LOCAL RESOURCES AND WITH THE INVOLVEMENT OF LOCAL COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATIONS.

vi. OBJECTIVES

- To enable the rural communities, particularly the weaker section to design and implement economic programme to achieve sustainable development.
- To create awareness against exploitative nature of existing social order and to work towards an alternative society with social justice and human dignity.
- To organize rural women and enable them to spearhead development activities in order to eradicate Social evil and bring natural justice.
- Integrate sustainable livelihood programme through participatory approach by enhancing productive improvement activities.
- Organize rural mass to form Community Based Organization (CBOs) and Self Help Groups (SHGs) to manage their resources.
- To promote, guide, undertake, maintain and co-ordinate projects and programs for communities to become socially and environmentally aware and active for their development and self-governance.
- To promote sustainable agricultural practices along with agro-forestry and silvi-pasture.

- To set-up study groups for the study of social, economic and environmental problems and to take up appropriate activities leading to prosperity of marginalized groups with safe environment.
- To provide formal and non-formal educational facilities for the needy people.
- To help farmers in activities of a-forestation, micro-irrigation, livestock promotion, conserving soil, water, watershed and they are by to develop and conserve the.
- Natural resources and manage livelihoods on sustainable basis.
- To train youth and children of poorer families to develop their capacities and leadership qualities in order to mainstream the youth power for rural development.
- To promote health and self-reliance among deprived and vulnerable communities.
- To organize vulnerable families, especially Dalits and Tribal and empower them with necessary skills of livelihood options on sustainable basis.

vii. INTRODUCTION:

The organization has completed another fruitful year 2018-2019. The organization today has extended the services to over 499 villages in four districts, namely Tumakuru, Hassan, Chikkamagalore, Kodagu and Bangalore Urban.

During the current year, the organization implemented different projects to tackle existing problems such as providing community health care, micro- finance, women development, watershed development and capacity building programme for ensuring sustainable development programs with the involvement of community participation.

The IWMP watershed development project for specialist NGO under implementation in five talukas, Chikkamagalore district, is benefitting more than 2630 households. The major activities of the project are- organizing training programme on EAP and EDP trainings to SHGs, skill based trainings, preparation of business plans, providing marketing support and handholding services etc.

In Gubbi & Koratagere taluka, of Tumakuru district, the organization is implementing Mobile health clinic activities. The main activities include- primary health care services such as curative services for common illness, first aid referral services, family planning, immunization, sanitation and health education etc.

Abhivruddi has working as business correspondent to NABARD financial services limited and ICICIC bank, Bangalore The organization has implementing microfinance in 287 villages of Tumakuru, Hassan & Bangalore Urban districts. Micro finance activities had positive impact in respect of self-confidence, economic and social development for women SHG members.

Abhivruddi has carried out all the programs successfully and effectively with an experienced qualified staff's and volunteers. It has developed good rapport with community and respective government departments to avail the service for the development of the people.

viii. FIELD IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAMMES:

M/s Abhivruddi has organized the following programs with the support of the various Government Departments and other donors during the period under review:

- 1) **Child Helpline:** M/s Abhivruddi has been providing 24 x 7 services to the children or the families in distress by way of providing the required support in getting the required services, assisting in accessing the available services, identifying the child right violations and enabling the victims to exercise their rights etc.



- 2) **Kings Learning:** New features to teach spoken English through pre-recorded videos and one-on-one classes for job seekers, students and other aspirants. We have taught around 500 students in kaggalipura govt. school & JSS school of Bangalore.



- 3) **Micro Finance:** The organization has been implementing the program with the support of the ICICI in the district. The program is implemented in the districts of Hassan, Tumakuru and Chikmangalur districts. The recovery percentage is 90-95 per cent. The program has supported various income generating programs such as the animal husbandry, petty shop, purchase of autos etc.

Impact Of Micro Finance Activities:

- ❖ Women SHGs showed a positive impact in respect of building of self-confidence, social development and social empowerment
- ❖ Increased in net income and assets of the rural women of SHGs and reduction in the level of poverty because of intervention of micro finance by SHGs.

- ❖ SHG members were able to diversify their activities by undertaking non-farm and animal husbandry related activities.
- ❖ Positive changes in income levels and SHG members actively participated in community development activities.
- ❖ Women`s identification\recognition in the society as well with the several Governmental & non-Governmental Involvement.

4) **National Rural Drinking Water Awareness Program (NRDWP):** The program was implemented with the support of the Rural Water Supply Department. The program has covered five taluks in the district. The program involved organizing training programs to the GP members and the officials, awareness programs to the self-help group members and the schoolchildren.



- 5) **Breast Milk Awareness Program** the Leo Lacto Foundation funds the program. The program aims at enhancing the awareness on the issue and motivating the beneficiaries to contribute to the milk bank. The program also compensates towards enhancing the nutrition levels of the mother. The program is being implemented in the Tumakuru City and Gubbi town.
- 6) **Construction Of Houses And Distribution Of Solar & Homely Need Kits:** The Habitat for Humanity India supported the construction of the Houses for whom those totally lost houses in the flood effect of Kodagu Dist. The no. of beneficiaries covered was 25. Besides around 3000 Solar lights were distributed to the 10th Grade students and distributed homely need kits to flood effected families in Kodagu dist.



7) **Red Alert Program:** My Choice Foundation funds the program. The program is aimed at prevention of the sale and trafficking of the children. The activities carried out under the program includes mother's meetings in the anganwadi centers, carrying out programs along with various government departments such as the health, police and education. The program is implemented with the participation of the volunteers such as the Rakshaks and the Vigilance Committees at the village level. The program targets the mother, father and the child.

Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sanchaya Yojana: The program is implemented with the support of the Department of Agriculture and is aimed at soil and water conservation.

M/s Abhivruddi is also represented in the district Balbawan Committee and supports the various initiatives taken up by the committee. M/s Abhivruddi is also actively participating in the activities of the Fevord-K and CACL-K.

8) Kodagu House Rebuilt:

With help of local rotary club and Habitat for Housing, we have completed 25 houses for the people like who lost their house in flood, single women, physically challenged persons and low-income groups.
