Our Approach:

Action Initiative for Development (AID) is established in 2005 and working for the socio Economic and educational transformation of the manual scavengers, sapai karmacharies and socially excluded Dalit Communities with a specific focus on children youths and women in Karnataka. AID is focusing on transforming the lives of these communities by providing information , knowledge and capacity building. AID works for promotion of Education, livelihood, dignity and self-respect among socially and economically marginalised and manual scavengers and sapai karmacharies, dalit, adivasis, rag pickers and other informal workers.

VISION:

AID is committed to create strong and independent society without inequalities and discrimination and where everybody enjoys equal opportunities.

Mission

The foster democratic and equitable living environment, where all vulnerable people specially socially excluded, underprivileged, Girl children, Children, youth and, women's have access to Education, Health, Social Status and Sustainable livelihood opportunity, essential infrastructure service irrespective of their economic and social status.

Goals

Overall Social Economic and Educational development of socially excluded and underprivileged Marginalized dalit communities especially Children, youths and women from untouchable community and manual scavengers and sapai karmacharies.

1. Program Reach

During this year 492 children (Male: 245 Female: 247) were reached through Child Activity Center. Aided in basic education.

Parents of 219 children were reached. They are given the importance of education and government facilities.

A total of 85 school dropouts have been re-enrolled in Davangere city. (Male 51 Female: 34)

187 youth have been reached by the project in Davangere district. Fifteen youth committees have been formed.

A total of 77 youths have been given financial assistance to pursue higher education. (Male: 21 Female: 56 Total: 77)

64 youths have been given various types of vocational training. (Male:16 Female:48 Total: 64)

211 people participate in the manual scavenger's community meeting.

69 manual scavengers have been helped to avail credit facilities by Sapai Karmachari Development Corporation.

With the help of various donors, grocery kits for Covid relief were distributed to around 450 more families.

A covid vaccination program was conducted in 10 slum areas with the help of the health department.

2. Action Initiative for Development (AID) first fights against Covid 19.



Food kits have been distributed to 450 families with the help of TDH-G and NHRF. Food kits have been distributed to manual scavengers and poor Dalit families in eight areas of Davangere city namely Hoskundawada, Nituvalli, Chikkanahalli, Anekonda, Gandhinagar, Azad Nagar, SPS Nagar, Jagjivan Ram Nagar and Harihara, Channagiri. Poor families are unemployed due to lack of work during the Covid pandemic crisis. These communities are grateful when grocery kits are distributed.



Youths distributed pamphlets in ten areas to prevent the spread of Covid virus. Covid vaccination programs were organized in ten areas. More than two thousand persons have been vaccinated.



Ten youth relief volunteers were appointed in ten areas of Davangere district and awareness was created among them about the prevention of covid.



3. Children Empowerment.

AID has been running ten supplementary education centers in Davangere district for the past six years. Here, a conference has been built for the children of poor families with emphasis on basic education and supplementary learning. Most of the children have already learned to read and write well. Children are being given adequate information about life skills and child rights. Children are learning happily. In the evening from 5 to 7 PM the children are given supplementary education and they complete the homework given by the school teachers. Children are given extracurricular activities like drawing, singing, dancing.

4. Youth Empowerment.

AID has been helped youths in skill building and make them stand on their own feet. This has enabled them to sustain their family livelihood. In this aspect AID has helped 34 youths (M-7, F-27) in Computer training which is 3 months and 6 months respectively. 7 Women has been helped in enrolled Beautician course. The beneficiaries were: 1. Chowdamma, 2. Kavana, 3. Rekha, 4. Divya, 5. Usha, 6. Archana, 7. Soundarya. 7 youths have been supported for four wheeler car driving courses. There were 7 Girls have been dropped out from school and they have been identified by AID and they have been supported for Beautician course and they are enrolled into beautician and they are undergoing training.

The names of the Girls were: 1. Mahatamma, 2. Nethra, 3. Chandana, 4. Sakamma, 5. Ashwini, 6. Roopa and 7. Renuka. This has enabled the candidates learn skills and after that they can stand on their own feet and their income earning capacity has been enhanced.

1. It is a family belonging to Scheduled Caste, in which total four people live in this family and live by daily wage earners. Sagar Babu's elder sister Bhavana is studying M.Com. Sagar Babu has completed his education up to PUC. It is not possible to pursue BA degree as it is difficult to pursue further education. Then he aims to make a living by learning computers. After that he completed one year computer training at Keonics Institute with the help of Aid Institute. After getting a training certificate from Keonix, with the help of a friend, he joined the Davangere division of Metro Ford Car Company as an accountant. He has been working for the past three months. The company pays him a monthly salary of 11000 thousand. He wants to continue his education while doing this profession.

Aims to work in a big company with good experience. He told me that I am happy to work and help my family.

- 2. Dhanraj got car driving training with the help of AID organization and joined a courier office as a driver. He earns fifteen thousand rupees monthly. He has paid off the family debt and dreams of owning his own car in the future. Expresses gratitude to AID Institute.

5. Community Empowerment:

There were 403 manual scavengers have been identified in Davangere district. They have been given some facilities by the Central and State Governments as part of their rehabilitation under the MS Act.33 Manual Scavengers children applied for Tabs under Safai Karmachari Development Corporation. A total of 87 applications have been submitted to the Davangere Municipal Corporation in the year 2022 from the families of manual scavengers and other Scheduled Castes. Applications are made for the scholarship from children and youth from class VIII to graduation class. Scholarship money has been deposited in the bank account of 47 children and youth in 2022 for those who have applied for scholarship in 2021 to Davangere City Corporation. 73 children and youth who applied in 2021 have received scholarship money from Social Welfare Department. For the year 2022-23, 60 applications have been submitted to the Department of Social Welfare for scholarships from children and youth. 20 applications have been submitted to the Labor Department for the children's scholarship from the families having Labor ID cards. 6 children who applied earlier have received scholarship funds from the Labor Department.
