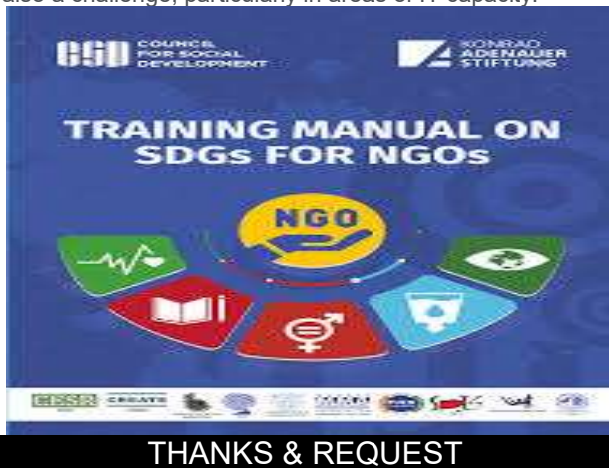
CAPACITY Building of CSOs

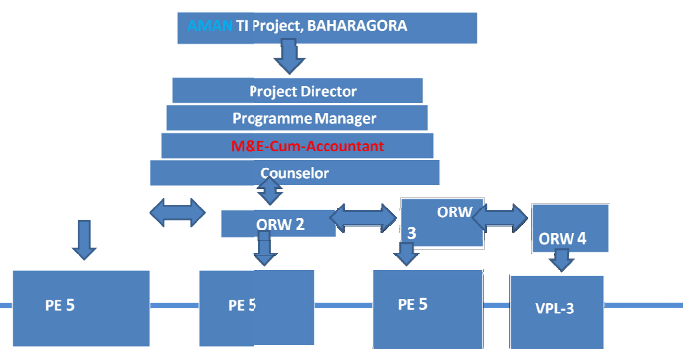
