The Organization got itself Registered in 2014 Under the Indian Trust Registration Act of 1882 to become a legal entity. In 2003 it was registered Under FCRA & in 2003 Registered with Income Tax Department and under 80G.

AMAN is outcome of an effort to address social issues, a need to empower the vulnerable part of the community; especially women and children, poverty stricken population living in remote, tribal areas, forest dwellers, artisans etc. Established in 2014, AMAN within this span of its interventions has implemented programmes to enhance the quality of lives of such persons, strengthening their respective financial capacity, emerging as a collective in different formats, SHCs, and be able to create assets to address their needs at own level.

In pursuance of its objectives, AMAN has implemented projects and programmes pertaining to women and child development, education for the children, addressed youth and adolescent issues, nutrition issues, women empowerment and protection, Health & sanitation, address livelihoods issues, financial inclusion and literacy etc.

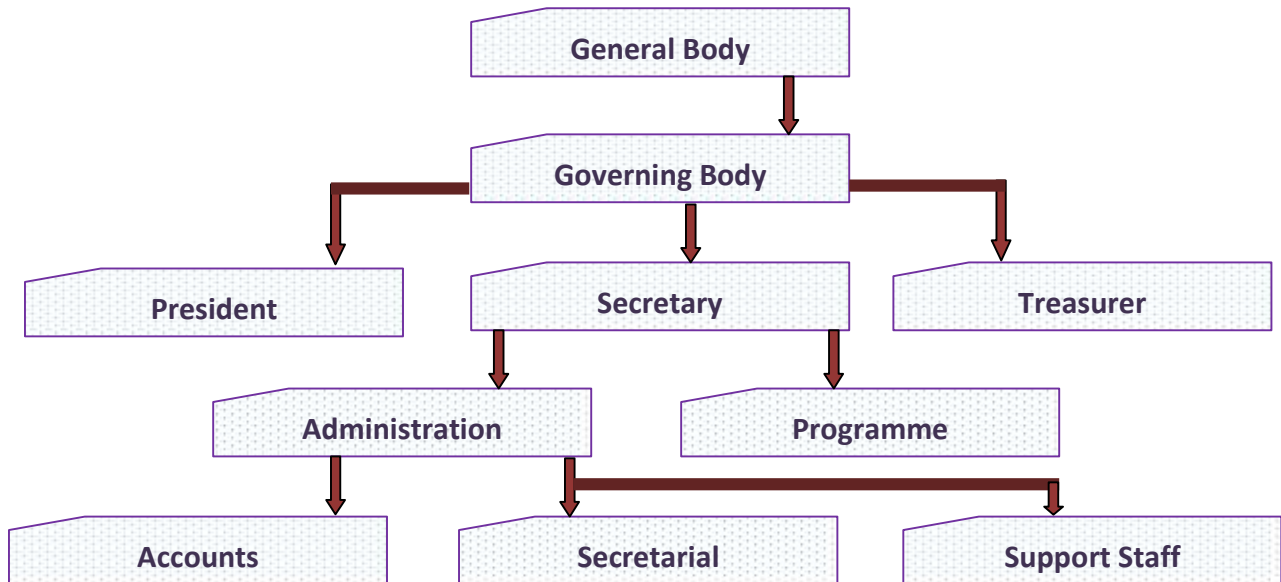

## Organization Structure

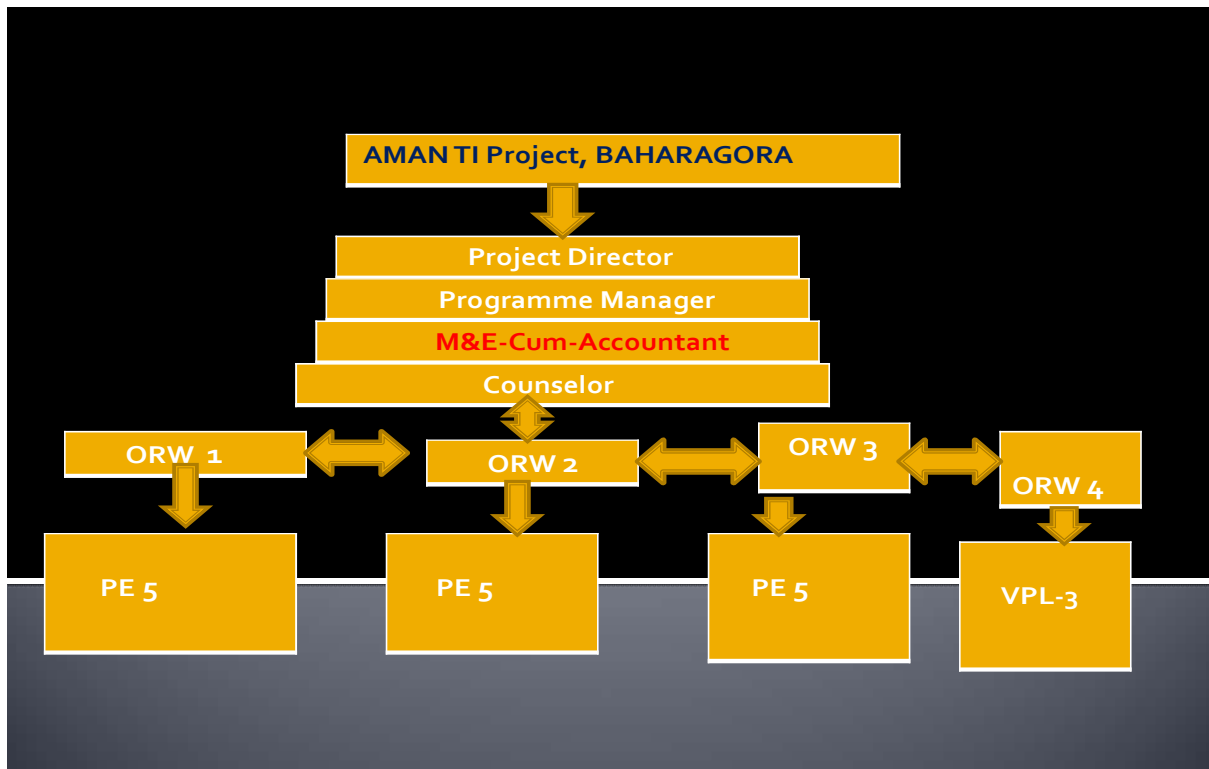

## Human Resources

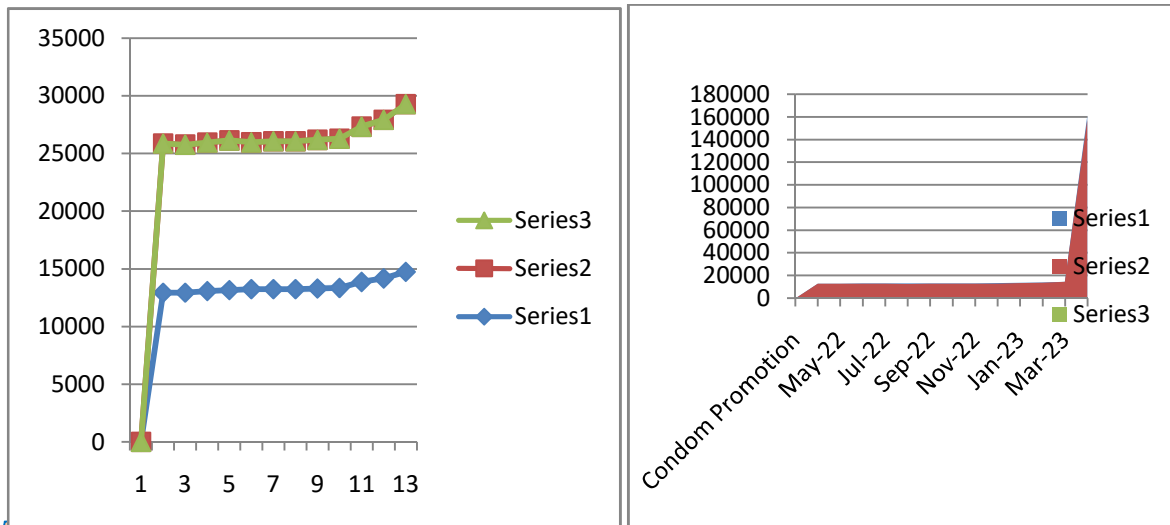

### TARGETED INTERVENTION PROJECT:

This is a running project and has been targeted to sensitize, aware & educate 900 of FSWs and 2500 Truckers at the Boarder area of Odissa, Bunal and Jharkhand along with provision of clinical services to prevent them from HIV/ AIDS Analysis the facts of East Singhbhum district for the targeted Intervention. The Socio- economic Scenario of the target area, identify the Core problems and need of the Community as well as assess the best alternatives in strong out the problem utilizing the available resources and participation of the Community. A part





from this same finding related to their Community family and Situation which forces them to adopt the occupation of Prostitution in the unorganized and hidden manner. She, by it too focuses on the knowledge and awareness on prevention care and management. In whole Scenario of EAST SINGHBHUM district among the Contacted female sex worker shows that about 26% of them as still engages in high risk sex practices where Condom use is rare and number of partners are many. About 54% of FSW contacted are in medium risk, which uses Condom in all penetrative sex acts, except with caretaker and lovers. Remaining 24% explained are in low risk category in all encounters with all partners. By the end of the year, the size of high risk group will be reducing. AMAN has adopted HIV Act Policy passed by GOI in 2017, details available at <https://1ngo.in/media/AMAN/HIV%20AIDS%20Act%202017.pdf>

Rangoli, Advocacy and Awareness Campaign were done by AMAN for HIV Free Society. Theme focused on Know AIDS to Stop AIDS and Toll Free Number 1097 was highlighted. World AIDS Day is commemorated around the globe on 1st December every year. It celebrates progress made in the battle against the epidemic – and highlights issues need to be addressed. Every year a theme is given “Stop AIDS, Keep Promise.

AMAN Team of TI Project conducted community base activities. 36 DIC Meeting, 72 Demand Generation Activities, 12 Monthly Meeting by PD, 5 Advocacy activities, 1 Health Camp 24 CBS Camp and solved 12 crises respond during the period 2022-23. 1097 Toll Free numbers has been highlighted by AMAN Team for HIV/AIDS prevention, Treatment, Education, Sensitization and control programmes in India. 1097 National Helpline has been contributing in making people aware about the prevention and educating people on HIV/AIDS.

### **COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign**

100% Covid vaccination project were executed by AMAN team. Vaccination has been lifeline to protect their life from Corona virus in the underserved area, Awareness, Campaign, IEC were conducted to achieve the goal.

### **HIV Prevention among Truckers**

Multiple and inter-related social norms associated with truck stop environments influenced HIV risk, including peer influence and expectations, presence of sex workers, ability to purchase sex throughout their travel and alcohol consumption. Vulnerability of truck drivers to HIV emerges from them being away from home and their regular sex partners for long period of time. The trucking industry is one of the largest employers in India. As a baseline, 30 million people are employed in the industry and more than 150 million people depend on it for their livelihood, according to industry estimates.

These Ways to Engage Truckers by AMAN TI: Bring Drivers into the Fold, Be Honest During the Hiring Process, Recognize and Reward Truckers' Families, Offer Ongoing Education and Training, Promote Driver Wellness, Offer Advancement Opportunities, Establish a Mentoring Program, Address & Solve Problems Quickly. During the year 2022-23 12 Demand Generation Activities, 12 Mid Media Activities and 6 Congregation Events done by AMAN.
