WHEREAS the need arises for public-spirited men/women to supplement the activities of the Government towards the welfare and development of the poorest sections of society.

WHEREAS Author of the Trust is having an insight to promote women empowerment and this is one of the concrete reasons to constitute the Trust.

WHEREAS the individual efforts had to be given constancy and continuity to further and perpetuate the activities of welfare and development.

WHEREAS the Author with a view to giving effect to the said desire constituted a Trust appointing the Trustees named in these presents as the First Trustees.

#### THE OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

##### General objective

- ✳ To empower women, children and unorganized labourers in all aspects such as in the field of social, cultural, economic, education, health and environment.

##### Specific objectives

##### Women:

1. To form self help groups comprising women from downtrodden families for enabling them to utilize their limited financial capacity for their economic up liftment.
2. To promote women empowerment programmes in rural, tribal and urban areas.

3. To improve the quality of rural women by organizing sensitivity programmes for them and promoting savings and credit unions.
4. To channelise their potential and enabling them to take up community development Programmes.
5. To orient the woman group leaders in facilitating their own group members.
6. To setup hostel for workingwomen who found difficult to stay in other places.
7. To establish short stay homes to protect and rehabilitate those women and girls, whom facing social and moral danger because of family problems, mental strain, social ostracism, exploitation or any other causes.

**Children:**

8. To bring the dropout children and abandoned children into educational system.
9. To establish preventive health care centres in rural and urban areas for the betterment of children.
10. To establish a home for orphan and destitute children and to provide rehabilitation programmes to facilitate for their wholistic growth.
11. To improve the life situation of child labourers and street children for their betterment.
12. To establish children's park for providing recreation to the children
13. To disseminate the significance of education for both the genders to the community at large.
14. To establish nurturing centre for children for caring, protecting and restoring their rights.
15. To setup model school for children to provide wholistic development in them.

**Un organised Labour:**

16. To conduct labour education programmes for unorganised labourers.
17. To protect and restore rights of labour in unorganised sectors.
18. To setup Resource Centre for disseminating various information related to labour in National and International area.

**General:**

19. To network with agencies for information sharing and garnering resources in the fields of education, health, environment, labour, human rights, agriculture, social, economics and culture for endowing to the communities.
20. To rejuvenate the individual's souls into pious deeds of love himself and others.

21. To enable the community to participate in social forestry for a non-pollution environment.
22. To promote eco-friendly clubs for protection of environment.
23. To promote sports and games at district level to channelise the youth's energies into national's sports mainstream.
24. To promote tribal community development programmes for their wholistic development.
25. It is deemed that the objects of the trust will be better achieved if the income of the trust is exempt under the income tax act. In case, however, a particular clause or clauses of the instrument of trust has been inadvertently clothed in a language capable of an interpretation in conflict with the relevant income tax provision the income tax act will always have overriding effect.

#### TO ACHIEVE THE OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

26. To establish, provide, organize, promote, maintain, manage, and render charitable and benevolent services and all other ancillary community development to the poor, the sick, the distressed, destitutes, old, orphan, homeless, disabled, refugees and victims of civil disturbances, riot, famine, earthquake flood, fire, pestilence, epidemic and other natural calamities, irrespective of nationality, community, caste, creed, colour, religion and sex.
27. To establish and maintain orphanages, crèches, nurseries, elementary, middle, secondary and matriculation schools, colleges and Technical Institutions for the benefit of the poor.
28. To establish and maintain Industrial, Technical and Agricultural works, Hostels, Boarding Houses, old age home and other similar Institutions. Hostel and Dispensaries without the intention of earning profit.
29. To provide, establish, maintain, control and manage educational institutions, libraries, research laboratories and workshops, computers and audio visual educational aids and all such other things as may be necessary or conducive to the said objects.
30. To publish magazines, periodical, pamphlets and to do all other things to disseminate, expand information for furthering the aim and objects of the trust.
31. To solicit, obtain or accept subscriptions, donations, grants, gifts, devices, bequests and trusts from any person, firm, Corporation, Trust, Institution or any Government Nationality & Internationality.
32. To make, file, defend, prosecute, intervene in petitions, suits, complaints, applications or any other proceedings before any Court, Commissioner, Tribunals, authorities of any other administrative, quasi-judicial or judicial bodies.
33. To acquire by gifts, purchase, exchange, leases, on hire or otherwise, how so far, any lands, buildings, easements and any other property movable or immovable and any estate or interest in furtherance of all or any of the objects of the Trust.
34. To build, construct and maintain houses or other buildings and structures and alter, extend, improve, repair, enlarge the same.

35. To sell, manage, lease, transfer, exchange, mortgage, demise, dispose off or otherwise deal with the property whatsoever belonging to the Trust.
36. To borrow and raise money with or without security or on the security of a mortgage charge or hypothecation or pledge over all or any of the immovable or movable properties belonging to the Trust.
37. To give loans, scholarships, prizes and monetary assistance to the persons pursuing the studies of consumer interest or public interest.
38. To give grants, donations, contributions, subsidies or any other monetary or otherwise to organisations or institutes, pursuing studies and activities for promotion and protection of consumer or public interest.
39. To invest, dispose of, transpose and deal with the monies of the Trust in such manner, as the Governing Body of the Trust may deem fit and proper from time to time.
40. To do all such other acts, deeds and things, as the Trust may consider incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Trust.
41. To initiate and encourage rural poorest women for their emancipation and fight against inequality(s) and also to provide welfare facilities for the women in distress.
42. To establish rehabilitation centres for Physically and Mentally challenged.
43. To promote and conduct consultancy service among the voluntary organisations and guide them to enter more relevant activities in their working areas.
44. It has agreed that Income and contributions that may be received shall be spend towards the promotion, objects of the trust and any incidental work connected and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to trustees by way of profit, interest, dividend etc.
45. To enter into arrangements, agreements with any Government of authorities whether Central or state, or municipal or local authorities otherwise seems to be conducive to object of the Trust to any of them and to obtain from any Government authority to such rights, grants concessions and privileges the Trust thinks desirable and to comply with any such arrangements and agreements.

#### GENERAL

46. The benefits of the Trust are open to all irrespective of caste, religion, sex, linguistic, etc.

#### AREA OF OPERATION

47. All the activities of the Trust shall be carried out only within the territorial limits of India and no activity of the trust will be carried outside India except soliciting donations/grants/contributions from outside India. The trust shall not carry on any activity with the intention of earning profits.

#### CONSTITUTION

48. The trust shall consist of a President and an Executive Director and from time to time in office shall be referred to collectively as Board of Trustees.
49. Mr.A.Sivasamy shall be the President and Mr. G.Ayyappan shall be the Executive Director and Mr. G.Prabu shall be Financial Trustee, shall be entitled to continue as such during their lifetime.

50. After MrA.Sivasamy , Mr.G.Ayyappan and Mr. G.Prabhu, their heir and the eldest member of their family automatically will become the President / Executive Director/Financial Trustee and he/she shall be vested with all powers to function as President / Executive Director/Financial trustee stated in this deed right from the day of his/her inception as President / Executive Director/ Financial Trustee.
51. The Trustees will be entitled to reasonable honorarium for his services to the Trust.
52. The other Trustee or Trustees shall be chosen by the Trust Board, if so desired with the consent of at least of two thirds of Trustees including President and Executive Director.
53. The other Trustees shall hold office for a period of two years and they shall be reappointed or terminated with the consent of both President , Executive Director, Financial Trustee and the other trustees limited to five.

#### ADVISORY BOARD

54. The Board of Trustees shall constitute an advisory board in regard to the conduct and affairs of the Trust and its activities. The Board shall determine the persons who shall constitute the advisory board, the terms and conditions of their appointment and their tenure. However, the advisory board shall consist of persons who are experts in various fields which are relevant to the objects, scheme and activities of the Trust and whose presence in the advisory board shall be conducive to the purpose and affairs of the Trust.

#### POWERS OF PRESIDENT AND EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

##### PRESIDENT:

55. The president shall guide the functions of the Trust. He/she shall conduct the proceedings of the Board of Trustees. In case of tie he shall have a casting vote. He shall act as presiding officer for elections, if he is contesting any other member nominated by the committee shall conduct election.. He shall have the power of monitoring the whole activities of the Trust and will coordinate with the Secretary in this respect.

##### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

56. Executive Director shall draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, negotiate, execute and en cash cheques and bills of exchange and other negotiable instruments. Without prejudice to this general power, in consultation with the president the secretary shall also have power to incur expenditure for the administration of the trust, collect funds, grant loans to staff, members and others as it may deem necessary, take all actions, legal or otherwise before any court or authority whatsoever in the name of the trust as may be decided by the Board of Trustees from time to time. The Executive Director shall operate the bank account jointly with Financial Trustee.

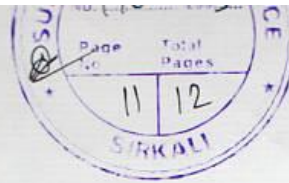
### FINANCIAL TRUSTEE

57. Financial Trustee shall maintain the accounts of the trust and present audited statements of accounts. He shall operate the bank accounts jointly with Executive Director.

### POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES

58. All the properties, funds and assets of the Trust shall vest in the Trustees and they shall be in complete management of the affairs of the Trust.
59. The Executive Director shall have the power of administration, employment, removal of employees etc.,
60. The Board of Trustees may meet for the dispatch of business, adjourn and otherwise regulate their meetings, as they think fit. The Executive Director shall summon meetings of the Board of Trustees. The Executive Director shall be entitled to exercise one additional casting vote in the event of equality of votes.
61. The trustees shall have power to augment the funds of the Trust from any source by accepting donations, voluntary contribution of any kind if they think such acceptance is in the interests of the Trust.
62. Without prejudice to the above said general powers and so as not in any way to limit or control these powers, the trustees shall have the powers: -
- a) To receive donations in any form, such donations shall be received irrecoverably.
  - b) To purchase or take lease lands, buildings, equipment, materials and other items.
  - c) To erect and maintain buildings and other constructions and to sell mortgage, dispose of or otherwise deal with any or all of them, as the trustees may think fit and proper.
  - d) To grant loans or borrow money as they may think fit and proper to control and manage the assets of the trust.
  - e) To constitute any committee or sub-committee/s from among the members or from outsiders and to invite eminent persons in the field to be advisors.
  - f) To execute, become party to, sign, acknowledge, perfect and register all deed, contracts, amounts, receipts and other documents and writings and to give effectual discharge on behalf of and for the trust.
  - g) To borrow from time to time such sum or sums of money at such interest for such period and on such terms as the trustees may think fit and secure payment thereof with interest.
- h) **OPERATION OF BANK ACCOUNT**
- i) To open and close accounts in the name of the trust, in any nationalised bank, Post office or other government institutions and to operate such accounts and otherwise deal with the same.
  - ii) To operate bank accounts by joint signature of "Executive Director and Finance Trustee in the event of anyone not present for longtime then the Executive Director shall sign with the discretion of other trustees.
- i) To insure or keep insured all or any of the buildings or assets of the Trust.
- j) To delegate all or any powers, authorities and direction vested in the trustees and generally to carry out such transactions as they may consider expedient in the interest of the trust and to make all such arrangements and to do such acts and things on behalf of the trust as may be usually necessary, desirable or expedient in the management of the affairs of the Trust or in carrying out its objectives.

#### ASSETS OF THE TRUST

63. The trust assets shall comprise of all funds received as donations, whether as corpus fund or otherwise, all income, the investments, movable and immovable properties acquired by gift, purchase, lease or otherwise and all the properties shall be held in the name of the Trust.

#### ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

64. The financial year of the trust shall be 1st April to 31<sup>st</sup> March. The accounts shall be closed on 31<sup>st</sup> March every year. The accounts shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant or by a firm of Chartered accountants every year in accordance with the provisions of the Income tax Act and other acts applicable to Trust. All funds of the Trust shall be vested in banks or securities in accordance with the provisions of the income tax and other relevant acts applicable to this trust.
65. The trustees shall from and out of the income realised from the properties of trust, and from such other endowments/grants, which may be received from government and donor agencies from time to time expend such sum/s of money, as they may deem fit and proper towards.
66. The maintenance of the properties of the Trust in good and tenable condition.
67. Pay all taxes and rates.
68. Pay such sums towards the repayment of any borrowing by the trustees on behalf of the Trust.
69. And meet all expenses, which the trustees may in their discretion think necessary for the proper and efficient management of the projects, programmes and institutions of the Trust.
70. In particular to pay the salaries of the staff, allowances, purchase of books/equipment/vehicles/furniture, pay management contribution for PF and other welfare measures of the staff and incur any other expenditure relating to the objects of the trust. However it shall be understood that the above enumeration does not give priority to any particular item of expenditure nor it is exhaustive.
71. The funds of Trust shall be utilised solely towards the objects of the trust and no portion of it will be utilised for payment of Trustees by way of profit, interest, dividend, etc.

#### AMENDMENT

72. The trust deed may be amended by a resolution passed by two-third majority of the entire Board of Trustees at a meeting of trustees specially convened for the purpose after giving minimum 15 days notice. If any trustee is unable to attend such a meeting he shall give his opinion in writing either for or against the amendment specifically.
73. However amendments to any clause/s in the Trust deed will be carried out only with the previous approval of the concerned commissioner of Income tax.

#### DISPUTES AND ARBITRATION

74. All disputes arising between the trustees themselves both life and ordinary and the dispute between the Trust and its employees on any matter or subject relatives to the affairs of the trust shall be decided by a board of three arbitrators appointed by the

Board of Trustees from time to time and the award of the arbitrators on such matters shall be final and binding on all parties concerned.  
75. This will be purely a charitable organisation on the object of mitigating human sufferings run on a "No profit" "No loss" basis principle.

**DISSOLUTION**

76. This deed of declaration of trust and the deed herein declared as irrevocable. However three fourths of the trustees shall decide to dissolve the trust and in such an event the properties shall be transferred to societies/trusts with similar objects and registered under appropriate legislations
