#### Yamuna Cleaning Drive – A Citizens' Movement for a Cleaner Delhi

Inspired by the ongoing efforts of the Delhi Government, Bandhutva Foundation has taken a proactive step in rejuvenating the sacred Yamuna River. Every weekend, we conduct a Yamuna Cleaning Drive, uniting communities, students, and volunteers to restore the river's dignity and ecological balance. The cleaning drive includes meditation and yoga sessions for centralising our focus, debate and discussions to widen our vision, and a nature walk to understand the mindset of youth.

So far, we have:

- Engaged **100+ dedicated student volunteers**, including **NSS volunteers**
- Successfully cleaned **6 major ghats** across Delhi, including **Vasudev and Sur Ghat**.
- Reached over **6 lakh people** through extensive **media coverage and interviews**.
- Reached **16 thousand people through our Instagram page**.
- Collaborating with social media influencers and leaders of society on environmental sustainability.

This is more than just a cleanup, it's a movement for environmental justice, civic responsibility, and community empowerment. Together, we're not just cleaning a river, but rebuilding a relationship with our environment.

### Mental Health Support

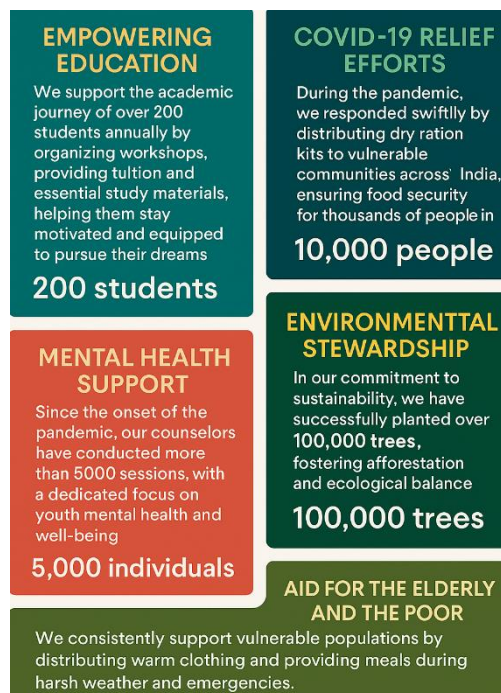
Since the onset of the pandemic, our counsellors have conducted more than **5,000 personalised sessions**, with a dedicated focus on youth mental health and emotional resilience.

### **Aid for the Elderly and the Poor**

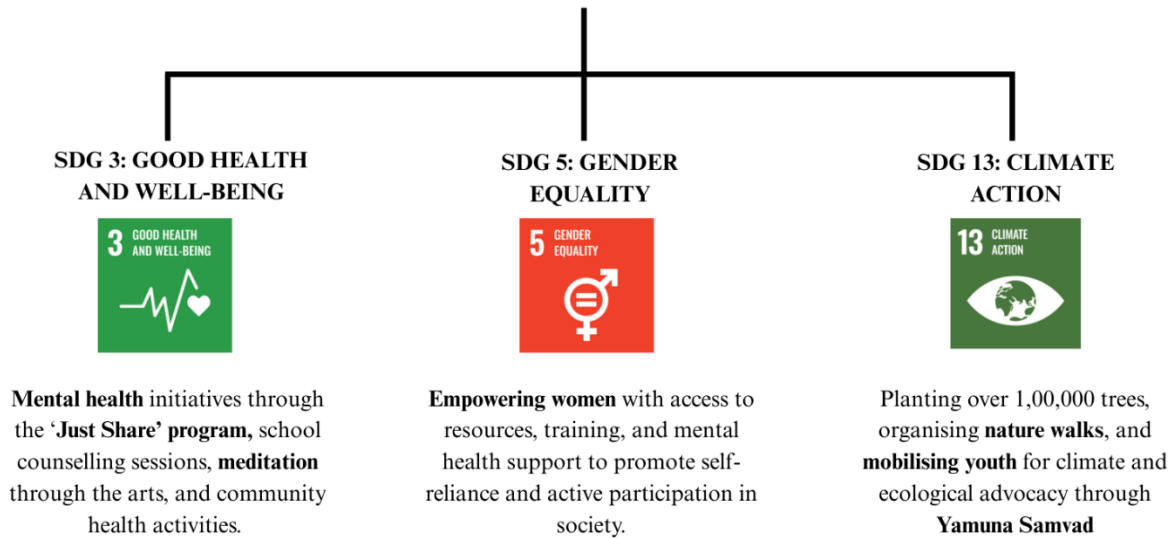
We consistently support vulnerable populations by distributing warm clothing and providing meals during harsh weather and emergencies.



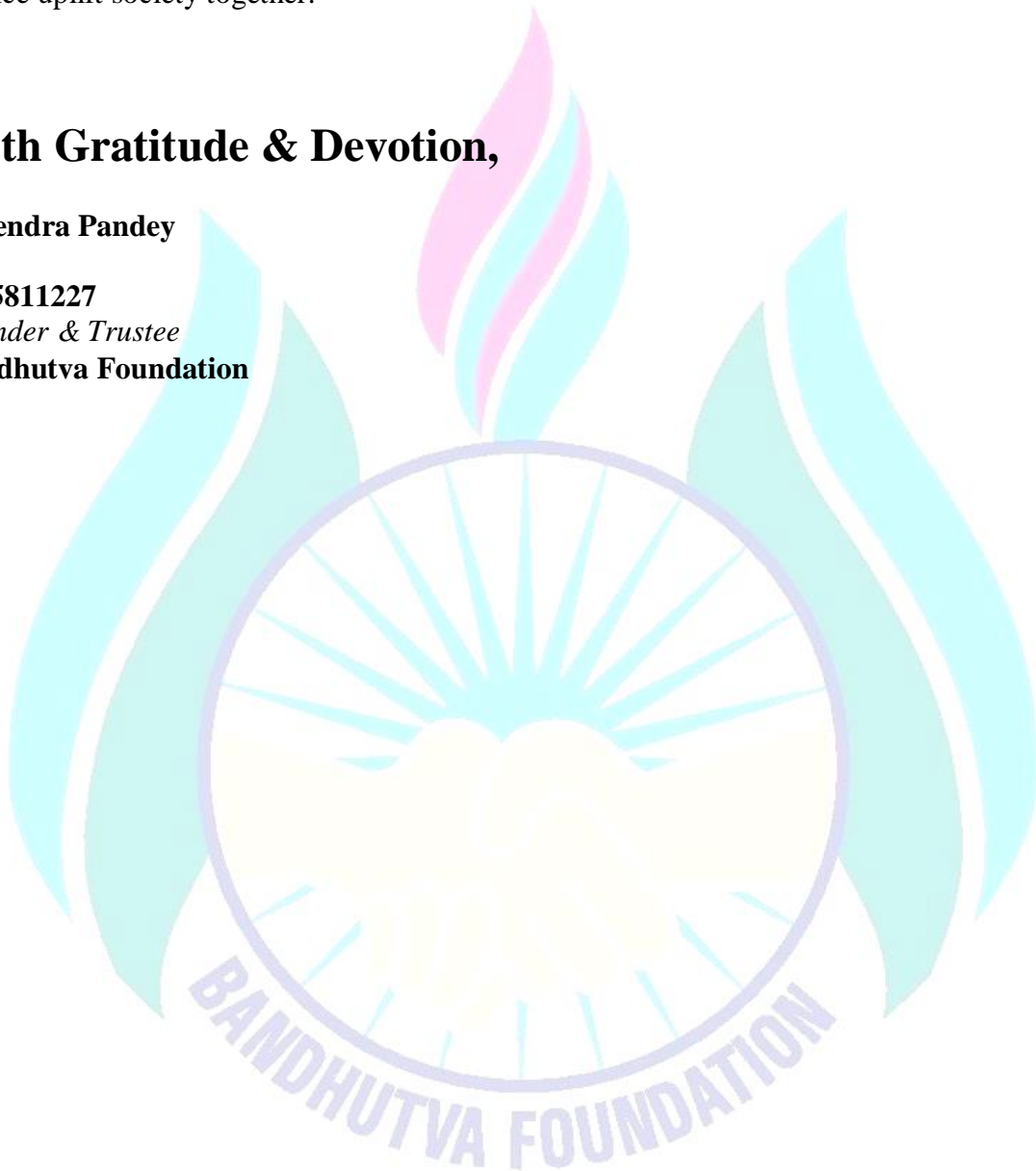

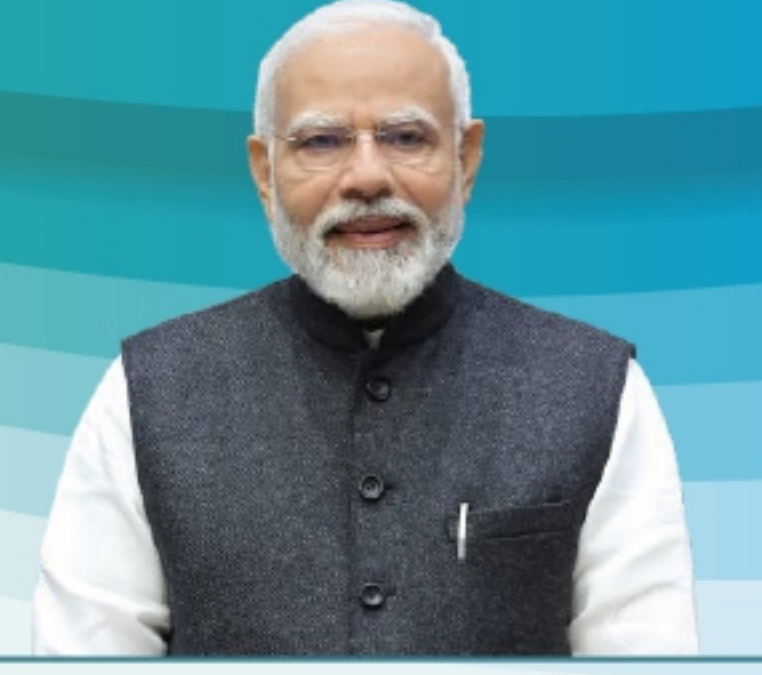

## Introduction:

Bandhutva Foundation, in collaboration with **Namami Gange and Yamuna Task Force**, successfully organized a large-scale **Yamuna Cleaning Drive**. The event aimed at cleaning the riverbank, spreading environmental awareness, and encouraging youth participation in river conservation efforts. This initiative brings together NGOs like Harit Yodha, Har Ghar Paudha, Aanchal Foundation etc., NSS units of Sri Aurobindo College, Miranda House etc., and local youth to promote environmental stewardship. The drive focuses not only on cleaning the riverbank but also on building long-term awareness about preserving rivers as essential lifelines for our ecosystem and communities.

## **Objectives of Yamuna Cleaning Drive:**

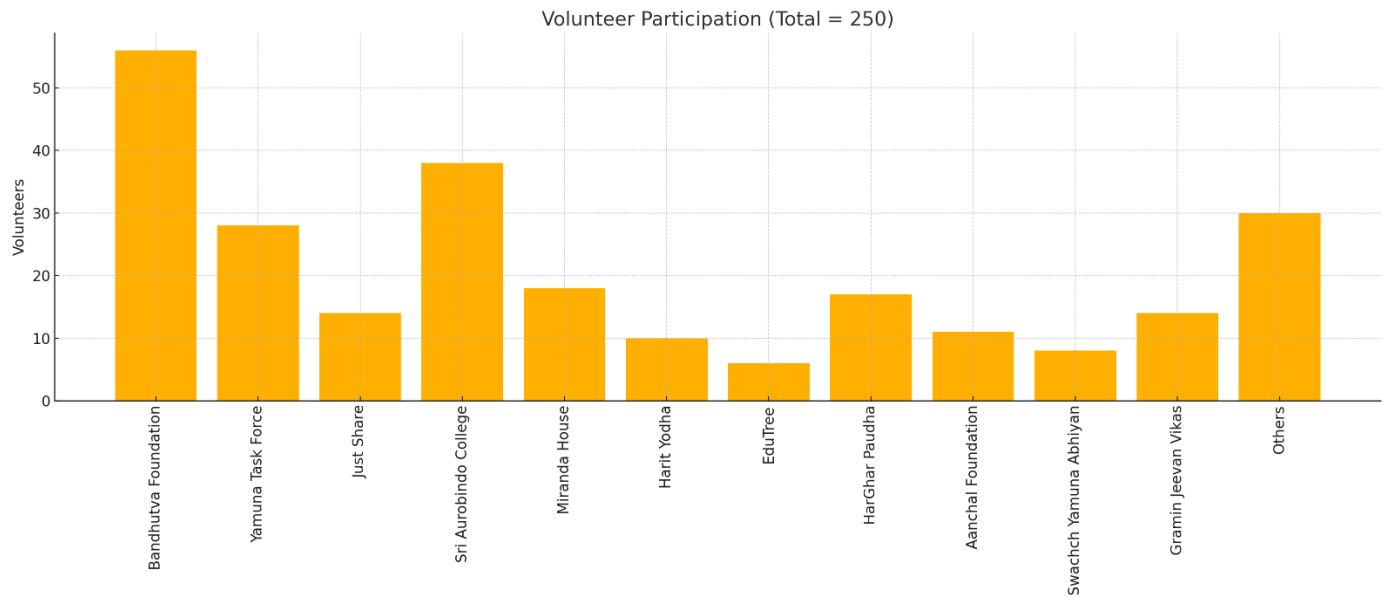
- Promote awareness on environmental conservation and river health

- Clean the Yamuna riverbank and remove accumulated waste.
- Raise awareness about environmental protection among youth and communities.

- Strengthen the message: “One Person, One Place, One Mission – Service to Maa Yamuna”.

**Vision:** To create a sustainable, clean, and ecologically balanced Yamuna river ecosystem through community-driven action, youth participation, environmental education, and responsible waste management practices. To work towards a Clean, Pure, and Free-Flowing Yamuna. Build sustainable river-cleaning participation models. Engage schools, colleges, NGOs, and communities in long-term conservation efforts.

## **Volunteer Participation Summary:**

A total of around **250+** volunteers took part in the drive, representing multiple NGOs and college NSS units.

Their collective effort demonstrates the power of unity and youth-driven environmental responsibility.



## Major Activities Conducted:

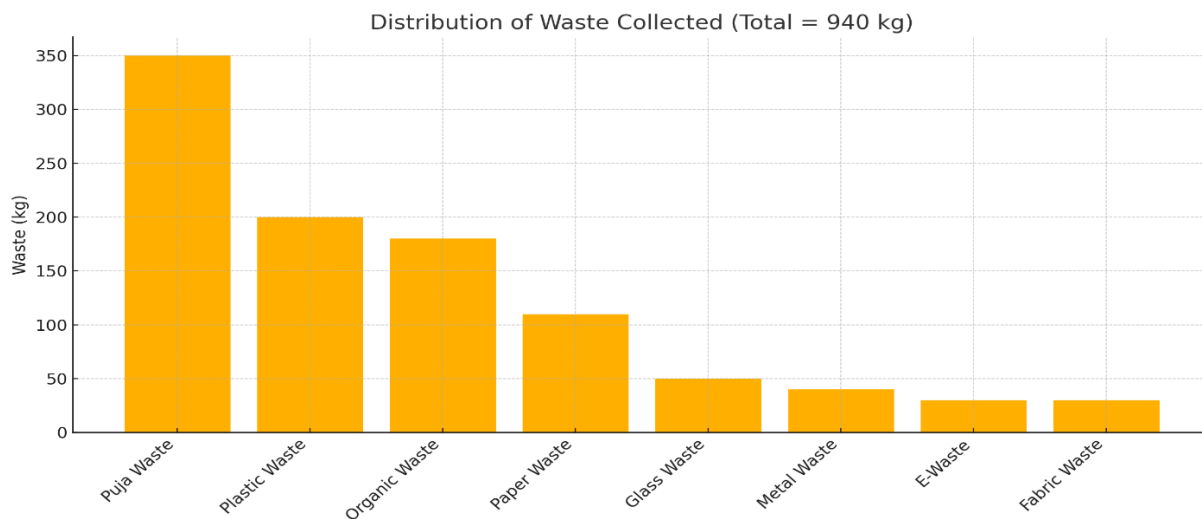
- Riverbank cleaning and waste removal

- Interactive sessions with college youth and social organizations to spread the message of Clean Yamuna and its long-term importance.
- Alignment of campaign goals with **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**, particularly SDG 6 (Clean Water), SDG 13 (Climate Action), and SDG 14 (Life Below Water).

## Waste Collection & Management Overview:

Total Waste Collected: **Around 940 kg**, showing the scale of pollution at the site.

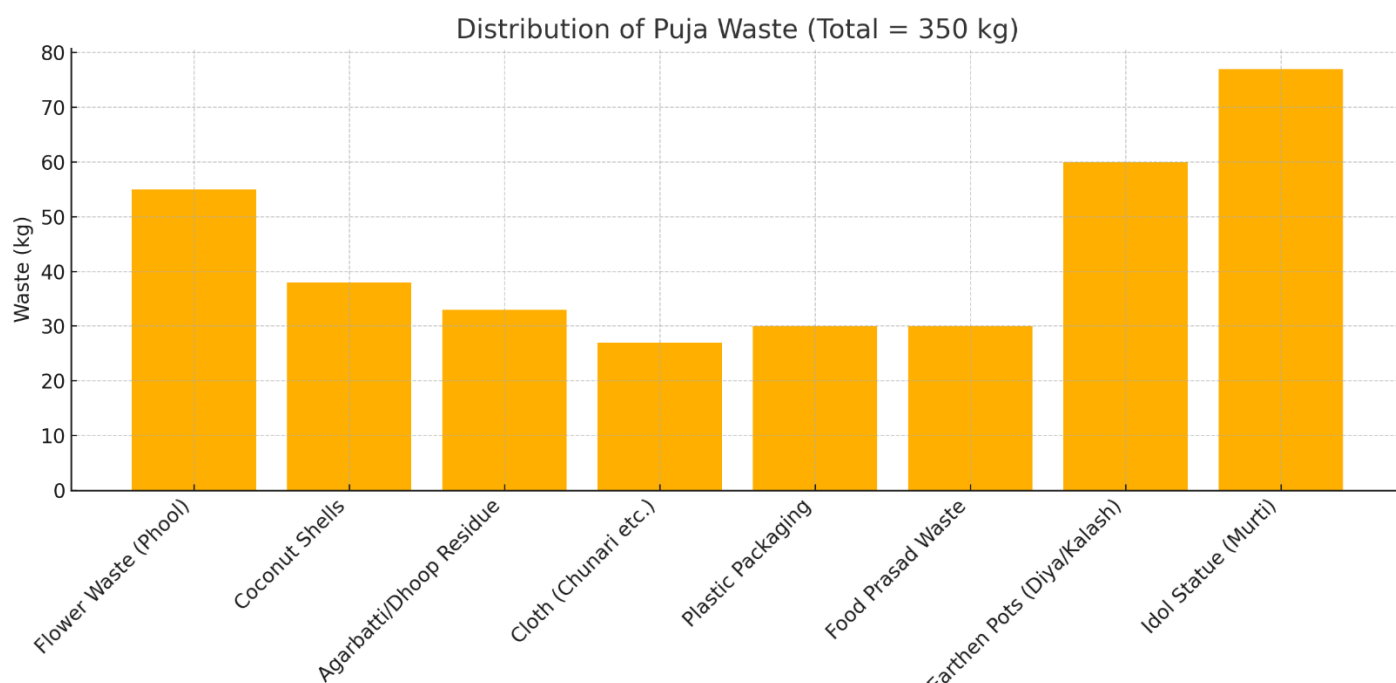
Puja Waste accounted for the highest share with **350 kg**, highlighting the pressing need for sustainable rituals and immersion practices. Other significant categories included- *Plastic Waste, Organic Waste, Paper Waste etc.* Smaller but crucial waste components included metal, fabric, e-waste, and glass waste. The data indicates the urgent need for waste segregation, ritual waste management, and regular clean-up drives.



## Detailed Breakdown of Puja Waste

Puja-related waste was further divided to understand the nature of offerings contributing to Yamuna pollution.

**Flower Waste and Murti** were the highest contributor, followed by Earthen pots and **Coconut Shells (70 kg)**. **Agarbatti/Dhoop residue (50 kg)** and **Plastic Packaging (45 kg)** highlight human-induced non-biodegradable additions. **Earthen pots, cloth offerings, and food prasad** formed the remaining components. This breakdown helps design targeted awareness campaigns on **eco-friendly religious practices**.



The detailed breakdown of puja waste clearly shows that religious offerings, though made with devotion, have become one of the largest contributors to Yamuna pollution. With over 350 kg of puja-related waste collected in just one drive, the problem is not occasional — it is persistent, growing, and deeply tied to cultural practices.

This makes puja waste not just an environmental issue, but a cultural challenge that needs a structured solution.

## That's Why We Need the **Yamuna Vahini Initiative** – An Urgent Call to Action

**Yamuna Vahini** is a focused initiative under **by Bandhutva Foundation** that works on:

- Collecting puja waste separately
- Providing eco-friendly idol and immersion options
- Creating designated puja waste bins at ghats
- Setting up flower composting units
- Running awareness drives before major festivals
- Engaging volunteers, priests, and local communities

It bridges the gap between **faith and sustainability**, ensuring that devotion does not damage the environment.

- Encouraged more NGOs and student bodies to engage in environmental causes

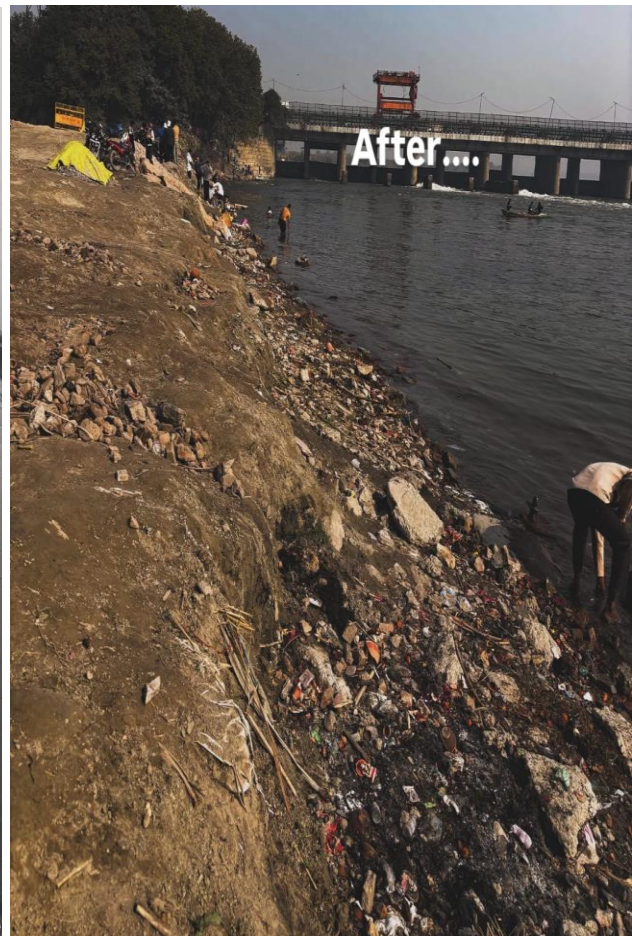
