## **01) Early Intervention and early Education: (EI &EE)**

On April 13, 2023, in collaboration with APD, a program was organized to distribute Poshan Powder kits to malnourished and underweight childrens, and the kits were distributed to 25 children's at the BIRDS Project Office in Bagalkot.



On April 27, 2023, a one-day training was conducted for the Anganwadi workers of Navnagar on Early Detection and Initial Training Scheme at Sector No. 2 Community Hall in which 37 workers and attendants participated.

On 31st May a distribution program of Aids & Appliances was organized for 19 childrens with the help of APD with the help of resource persons at the project office.



On June 14, 2023, 9 children of our project were screened in a assessment camp for children with facial and jaw disorders in collaboration with RBSK and DEIC in which 3 children were informed about undergoing surgery.



3 children were admitted and treated at the NRC center of the district hospital.



On July 12, 2023, by organizing a one day training for parents on homelessness, how to train and engage children at home, including pre-school education, how to support a child at an anganwadi center, in which anganwadi workers and health department staff participated along with parents and guardians. Share information. 72 children and parents participated in this program.



On July 25, 2023 and 26, 2023, a training of Village & Urban Rehabilitation Workers (VRW & MRW) was organized in which rehabilitation workers from all taluks of Bagalkota district participated.



On August 8, the World Early Childhood Education Day was celebrated in the Project office in which children dressed up in various costumes and the program was attended by 42 parents and guardians. 230 workers and district officials also participated.

On August 19, 2023, the inaugural function of Bagalkot District Carers Livelyhood producers Company was held at Shree Sai Mandir, Vidyagiri Bagalkot, in which Dr. Anil Patil, founder of Carers World Wide, and officials of the District Physically Handicapped and Senior Citizens Welfare Department and Selco Solar Foundation and various government officials and resource persons participated. Total Participants of 300 carers participated.



On September 4, 2023, the second level of parents training was organized at Project Office, Bagalkot in which around 63 childrens along with their parents Participated.

Annual Report 2023-24 of Coordination Education Scheme for Hearing Impaired Children

150 hearing impaired children of Bagalkota taluk and 75 children of Badami taluk and 75 children of Hungunda taluk with a total of 300 children, every day community teachers and coordinators visit schools and homes to teach the hearing impaired children through sign language every year 80% of the children are they have passed the SSLC exam. Accordingly, this year also 5 children have appeared for the exam. We are trying to bring coordination in the field of education by training stakeholders to help those children. We have done project trainings in collaboration with government and private school teachers and rural rehabilitation workers, ASHAs, Disabled welfare department, education department. Identifying and encouraging skills in hearing impaired children.

- To increase the participation of hearing impaired children in various activities.
- Building confidence in hearing impaired children.
- Bringing hearing impaired children on a single platform.

Organize activities to suit the needs of hearing impaired children and Enhance their skills.

- To create unity among the differently abled and help them to live a self-reliant life.
- Building concepts through extracurricular activities.

- To develop discipline, cleanliness, Individual hygin cooperation and leadership qualities.
- Allowing sisters/brothers of Deaf & **Dumb** children to be separated from all children.
- A summer camp for hearing impaired children was organized from 22-04-2023 to 28-04-2023 in which children from Bagalkot, Badami and Hungund taluk participated. Sign language and extra curricular activities were organized for the childrens, resource persons from APD Bangalore participated and trained the children.
- First of all, the children and parents who have arrived from all the Rural and Urban are gathered and then the Taluk Coordinator welcomes those children.



He requested, informed the children and parents about the purpose of conducting this camp as a 5-day summer camp for children and parents. Awareness and training on character, Indian Sign Language (ISL) training, school bags and learning materials were distributed to the Children in the camp.

Similarly, BIRDS Hungund and Selco Foundation are helping the carers to become self-employed by installing solar energy for Rothi making machine, Xerox machine, sewing machines at low cost in their house. So far, a total of 10 people have adopted solar from SELCO Foundation. The company plans to help more carers become self-employed by adopting solar in the coming days.

For each entrepreneurship awareness training [EAP] program, project staff such as team leaders, experts in income generation activities, Assistant Director of Agriculture, Agricultural Officer (Technical-II), Assistant Agricultural Officers, resource persons, monitoring and evaluation staff, Gram Panchayat Chairpersons, members of Women's Self Help groups, Department of Agriculture. Bailahongal and the implementing organization BIRDS Hungund also participated. Total of 686 women members participated.

In each of the training programs, the leaders, income generation experts spoke about the project. Later, the resource person Mr. Hanumanthappa K addressed the training program and said that the members of women self help groups have the right to choose the job of their choice. In order to improve the livelihood of the landless, social and economic.

The situation needs to be improved. The main objective of the income generation activities is to help the weaker section of the society to earn more income through landless income generation programs that are beneficial to

them and to increase their skills and earn an income of at least Rs.5000/- per month.

Farmers can increase their income by engaging in other income generating activities like dairy farming, sericulture, fish farming to become financially prosperous. He said that this scheme is an important scheme of the Government of India. It has helped the small and micro entrepreneurs, farmers and landless poor unemployed people to become economically strong by taking up non-agricultural income generating activities for livelihood and sustainable development.

❖ **Self-Employment Development Programme (SEDP):**To identify actionable activities, information on self-starting the landless/vulnerable class group members to improve their standard of living will be imparted in Entrepreneurship Awareness Training-E.A.P. Further work activities will be carried out by non-governmental organizations selected by the Watershed Development Department to conduct the EAP. He said that the EAP will be conducted within a year after the formation of Self Help Groups is completed and a program will be developed in the counter-sub-watershed.

❖ **Eligibility to select members for Entrepreneurship Awareness Training:**

❖ Newly formed self help groups will be given first priority under this scheme.

:

❖ After ranking the existing groups, those groups can also be selected for EAP training if they are not getting financial support from other schemes.

❖ **Eligibility Criteria:**

- If any member has received assistance for income generating activities under any other scheme, such member shall not be eligible for the same.
- Priority should be given to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes, Landless, Professional Poor, Handicrafts and Small Farmers.
- Age limit should be between 18 to 60 years/

- The association should have the ability to borrow for any purpose and repay it.
  - A member who defaults on loan due to any reason cannot be selected.
  - It was also said that if any member of the weaker section is unable to participate in the scheme by being in the self-help group, one of their children can be selected as the beneficiary.
- ❖ **Selection of Members for Entrepreneurship Awareness Training:**
- Self Help Group has the primary responsibility of selecting members for EAP. Non-Governmental Organizations are providing all kinds of support for this.
  - Non-Governmental Organization and Watershed Committee should conduct a review to know whether the selection has been done based on the above selection criteria. Property grading can be used for this purpose.
  - The members were informed that inspection may be carried out by the department and the monitoring and evaluation agency to ensure the eligibility of the selected candidates.

In each training program, information was collected about the women's self-help group members interested in doing any kind of job. In addition, they were also informed about the loan from Bank A. Basavaraja Dalwai, Assistant Director of Agriculture, Bailahongal Agriculture Department, spoke to the women's self-help group members.

He said that they should improve their standard of living and increase their income by choosing their own job and doing income generating activities. Supervisors of Bailahongala Taluk Panchayat AN.RLM also participated in this training and said that they will make sincere efforts to provide necessary assistance of Banka to the women about the facilities available from their schemes and employment. Besides, Nayanagar Canara Bank Manager also participated in this training program to teach the members of Mahila Self Help Society how to use their savings and how to lend it to the members, how to follow the steps to give loans & how to repay the loan. On 09-01-2024 left Bagalkot at 9.00 AM and reached Sirsi at 5 AM, then visited Beekeeping Livestock Training Center Kallalli Mane Training Institute.

50 members of Self Help Society and farmer women from Badami taluk had joined for field beekeeping. After breakfast at 11.00 am we attended the training institute, Mr. Madukeshwar Hegde, the head of the training institute started the training and told us how our training institute came into existence.

Beekeeping is an industry so it is very simple and activity for you women to earn income by doing this job. The farmer told the women that they can get Rs 3000 as a subsidy from one box every 3 months. He showed practically that many products can be made from jain. Honey, bee jam, bee lipstick, there is one more expensive honey called royal honey which costs 8500 to 10000 per 10g and is used by movie actors and rich people, IAS officers and politicians it prevents aging of man.informed that And also introduced Aryurvedha medicines.



He practically showed me the honey strips and told me that if you want them, if you order them in advance, they will send them to you.

After the field study the places of interest like Sri Marikamba Temple were visited and Sri Madhukeshwar Temple at Banavasi was visited. Then on 10-01-2024 at 9 PM from Sirasi to Bagalkot and reached Bagalkot and Hungund at 5 AM.
