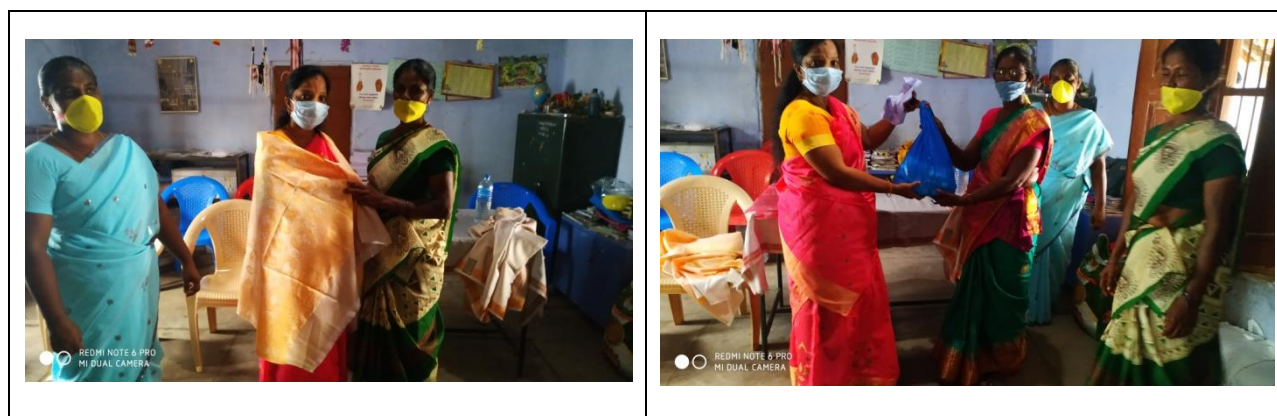
Dear Friends, Sisters and Brothers,

Distribution of Dry Ration for Corona Relief



Deepam NGO distributed the dry ration to the parents of the Children's Home at Harur on June 11th 2020. Mr. Sampath, MLA of Harur Constituency presided over the program.

COVID 19 by following the instructions – washing the hands frequently, wearing the mask regularly, keeping the social distance of 2 metres, avoiding to gather in crowds, drinking of kabasura kudi neer, Ginger Tincture (Juice); If you are the symptoms of fever, cough and cold, immediately it is better to go to hospital for the treatment. Deepam NGO distributed rice, soap, hand wash sanitizer, masks and Grocery items to 30 parents of the home children. Mrs. Kaleeswari, home teacher addressed the vote of thanks at the end of the program.

Scheduled Caste and Tribes Welfare Committee Meeting

The scheduled caste and tribes welfare committee meeting was held at Sub Collector's office premises on 22nd September 2020. The Sub Collector, Harur Constituency MLA, Morappur Constituency MLA, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Block Development Officer, Harur, Tahsildar, Panchayath President, Ward Members and committee members attended the meeting.



It was decided that to inform to the committee about violation made against the SC/ST people, creating awareness on SC/ST on legal support extended by the government, steps to be taken to the victims of violated persons for financial compensation from the government. Awareness and Vigilance Committee was formed at Harur Sub Divisional level to take steps against the said incidents if anything was happened.

Joint Liability Group meeting was held at Deepam NGO office premises on 30th November 2020 on behalf of the NABARD, Dharmapuri.

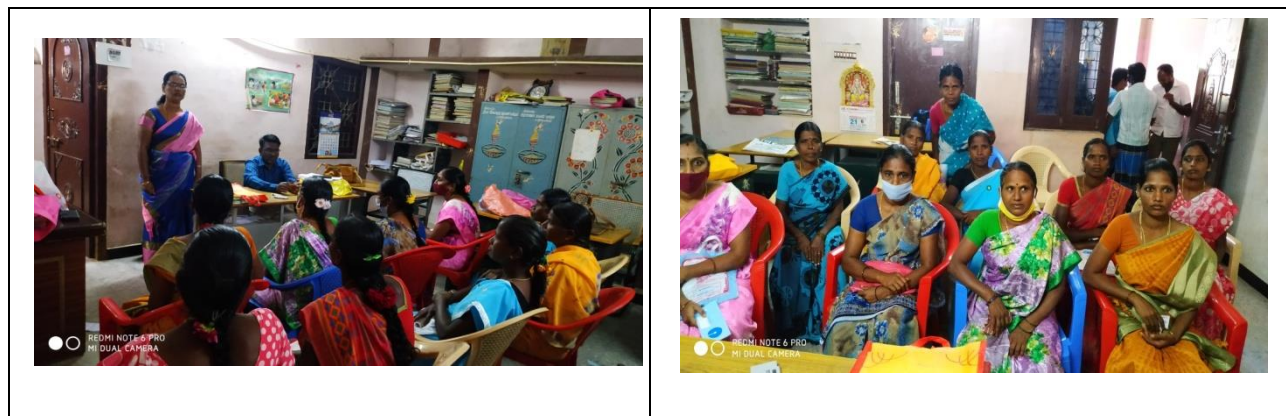

Valedictory and MEDP Training Certificate Distribution Function

Training on Agarbathi (Incense Sticks) production was conducted from 20th January to 7th February 2021 at Deepam Training Centre. The participants were trained in how to purchase the raw materials, mixing the raw materials with ratios, drying the sticks in the sun light, colouring, how to operate the machine, drying the agarbathi, packing and marketing in an effective manner with full efforts. At the end of the program day on 7th February 2021,



Mr. Pravin Babu, District Zone Manager had interactions with the trainees. He asked about the training, future plan after completion of training. Some of the trainees interacted that they will go to work to agarbathi production companies on monthly waged basis and some of them said that they will approach the banks for loan to start the agarbathi unit to work on self employed. The Zone Manager issued the training completion certificates to all the participants.

DhWANI Foundation Network Program

DhWANI Foundation based on Bangaluru has formed a Network program in the name of Nirandra Project to strengthen the NGO's fund raising capacity through CSR funds and other funding sources. The foundation has selected one NGO per district and totally 32 NGOs have been selected in all over Tamilnadu.

Corona (COVID 19) Awareness Services

Due to pandemic and vast spread of Corona Virus, the lock down is in force with some relaxations.

The government has initiated to follow the following three instructions strictly to prevent and infect from the corona virus attack.

- Wearing the mask to be ensured to close with mouth and nose
- Wash the hands with sanitizer / or soap water
