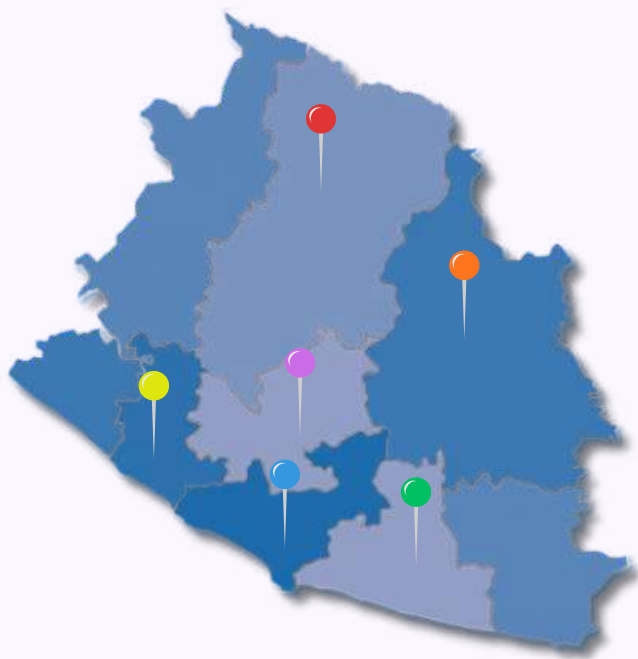
OUR MISSION

SKILLS THAT SPARKS

CHANGE

At Evanjalin Charitable Trust, we believe that lasting change begins with opportunity. For nearly two decades, we have worked alongside communities to create pathways for individuals to learn, grow, and achieve economic independence. Our experience has shown that even the smallest opportunity can unlock confidence, resilience, and transformative change.

Women often face barriers that limit their participation in income-generating activities, resulting in financial dependence and reduced decision-making power within households. In times of crisis, such as the loss or illness of a family breadwinner, many women struggle to sustain their families and maintain a dignified livelihood. Recognizing these challenges, we provide skill development and entrepreneurship training that enables women to become self-reliant and financially independent.

Through tailoring, Aari work, embroidery, beautician training, and other livelihood initiatives, women gain practical skills that open doors to employment and self-employment opportunities.

Recognizing that Kanyakumari District possesses unique local resources and traditional knowledge, we adopted a strategic livelihood approach that focuses on transforming locally available materials into marketable products. In partnership with the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation, we implemented geographically focused value-added product-making and entrepreneurship training across six blocks of the district. The programme was designed not only to impart technical skills but also to foster entrepreneurial thinking, business planning, product development, marketing, and income generation.

The programme has already demonstrated tangible results, with 23 out of 100 trained women successfully initiating entrepreneurial ventures. By combining skill development with entrepreneurship support, we are creating pathways for women to transition from beneficiaries to business owners, strengthening household incomes and contributing to long-term community resilience and economic growth.

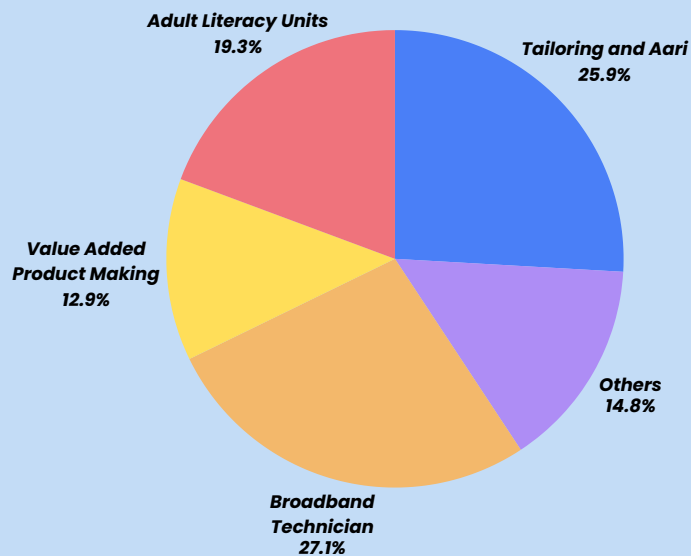

Kiruba's Journey Towards Financial Independence

A Beneficiary from waste flower reuse program

Before joining the Waste Flower Reuse Training Programme, I had no personal source of income and was financially dependent on my family. In January 2026, I participated in the training conducted by Evanjaline Charitable Trust, where I learned to transform discarded flowers into eco-friendly value-added products.

Inspired by the training, I started producing and selling liquid soap made from recycled waste flowers in March 2026. Today, this small enterprise generates an average income of around ₹3,000 per month, helping me contribute to my family's expenses and improve our financial stability.

Beyond the income, the programme equipped me with valuable technical and entrepreneurial skills, enhanced my confidence, and encouraged me to pursue self-employment. I take pride in creating environmentally friendly products while earning a livelihood. This opportunity has not only improved my economic condition but has also empowered me to become more independent and self-reliant.
