EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The financial year 2026–2027 began with a significant milestone for Evanjalín Charitable Trust through the launch of its first child development initiative—a **10-day Summer Camp for children**. Supported by generous donors, the program provided free painting kits and learning materials, creating an engaging environment where children developed their creativity through art and enhanced their communication skills through spoken English sessions. The camp culminated in an art exhibition that showcased the talents, achievements, and creativity of the participating children, while receiving positive appreciation from parents and community members.

Alongside child development initiatives, the organisation continued its focus on youth and women's empowerment through a **two-month vocational training program in tailoring**. The program attracted strong participation from women and youth, with 35 beneficiaries successfully completing the training and gaining practical skills in tailoring, design, and garment construction. These skills have the potential to enhance employability, encourage self-employment, and contribute to financial independence.

The reporting period reflects the Trust's commitment to fostering creativity, learning, and livelihood opportunities among vulnerable communities. Through targeted interventions in child development and skill training, the organisation continues to promote a society characterised by empowerment, inclusion, and sustainable development. The achievements of this period were made possible through the continued support of donors, partners, and community stakeholders.

TAILORING & AARI COURSE



Evanjalin Charitable Trust conducted a Vocational Tailoring and Aari Training Course as part of its skill development initiatives during the summer period. The course was designed to provide participants with hands-on training in tailoring techniques, garment construction, stitching methods, Aari embroidery, and basic fashion design concepts.

Participants were trained in cutting, stitching, finishing, decorative embroidery work, and garment embellishment techniques. The training provided a supportive learning environment where beneficiaries developed practical skills, creativity, and confidence in creating customised garments and embroidered products. The course also introduced participants to potential livelihood and entrepreneurship opportunities within the tailoring and fashion industry.

Children **AWARENESS PROGRAMS**

DIGITAL ADDICTION AWARENESS

Evanjalin Charitable Trust conducted an awareness camp on Digital Addiction for children. The session focused on helping participants understand the effects of excessive screen time, identify signs of digital addiction, and learn practical ways to maintain a healthy balance between online and offline activities.



CHILD PROTECTION AWARENESS

Evanjalin Charitable Trust conducted an awareness session on Child Protection for children. The session focused on child safety, recognizing unsafe situations, understanding personal boundaries, and seeking help from trusted adults when needed.



FUNDRAISING WORKSHOP

Representatives from Evanjalin Charitable Trust participated in the three-day Niranthara Saksham Fundraising Workshop organized by Dhwani Foundation on 15th, 16th, and 17th April 2026. The workshop provided valuable insights into fundraising fundamentals, donor management and engagement, CSR partnerships, due diligence requirements, proposal development, and organizational credibility.

Mrs Sindhu from Chettiarmadam always dreamed of earning an income through her own skills, but lacked the professional training and confidence needed to start a business. Her journey changed when she enrolled in the Beautician and Bridal Makeup Training conducted by Evanjaline Charitable Trust under the National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM).

During the training, she learned professional beauty care techniques, bridal makeup, customer handling, and basic business management. The hands-on experience and entrepreneurship guidance helped her gain the confidence to pursue self-employment.

Soon after completing the course, Mrs Sindhu started her own beauty parlour, Reshma Beauty Looks. What began as a small venture has now become a reliable source of income, enabling her to support her family while building a reputation within her community.
