The Industrial Tailoring Training Programme under the Ministry of Textiles is progressing successfully with 30 women beneficiaries. Through hands-on training, the participants are learning industrial sewing techniques using power sewing machines, along with garment measurement, cutting, stitching, finishing and quality control.

For many participants, this training is an important step towards becoming financially independent. In addition to developing technical skills, the programme is helping them improve their confidence, discipline and understanding of garment production.
