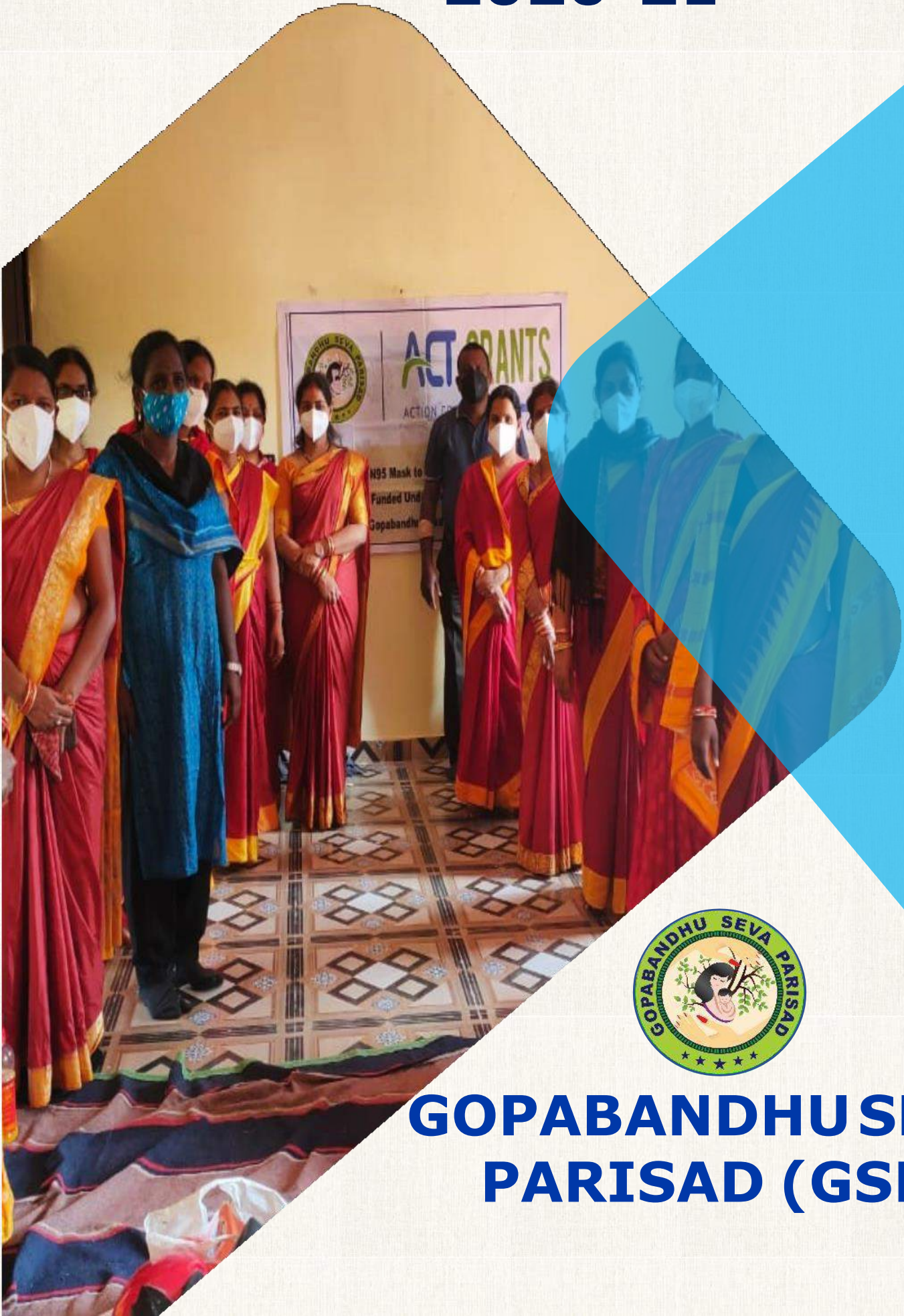

Project - Empowering Women PRI Leaders of Marginalised Community to Participate Effectively in The Local Self Governance with Dignity



Panchayat Raj Institutions (PRIs) are viewed as a solution to all the problems of rural development and is linked to the empowerment of the marginalized section of society, especially women. In this context, GSP with the support of the Center for World Solidarity is working on the empowerment of women representatives in PRIs concerning decentralisation process and the 73rd constitutional amendment in India covering the level of awareness among representatives about panchayat functioning, capacity to take self-decision, participation in Palli Sabha & Gram Sabha to discuss some key socio-economic issues which often remained undiscussed.

Also, the project emphasised plummeting women proxy leaderships and enhancing the decision-making power of women PRI leaders at the panchayat level and their political participation for fighting against women harassment, child trafficking, migration, country liquor, women rights, menstrual hygiene management inshools, creating women entrepreneur, education for dropout children etc.



- Under the project, Kolar GP was promote as Model Gram Panchayat
- Women participation in Palli Sabha and Gram Sabha is increased up to 83%
- GPs have equipped with revenue generation plans and they are collecting revenues from weekly market, community Pond, market complex, etc.
- Project villages are sensitised on Forest Right Act and application were submitted for land rights
- 2837 families linked with different public schemes & entitlements
- 416 persons from 4 GPs got employment through MGNREGS
- 39 persons facilitated to enrolled in different pension schemes
- 42 beneficiaries got work order for construction of Pucca houses under PMAY
- 227 farmers benefited from PM Kisan Scheme
- 1044 farmers linked with DBT cash benefits under KALIA scheme
- 1026 children insured with cooked & dry food at under Anganwadi centres
- Apart from these 5847 families got the benefits of PDS ration under COVID scheme.



Advocacy on Wash (Water, Sanitation & Hygiene) Rights

We work with the government and partners to ensure that every tribal person and child in the Boipariguda block of Koraput has access to clean water, basic toilets and practices good hygiene behaviours.



Collaboration and convergence are the key features of our programme where WASH is positioned as cross-cutting support contributing towards results in all aspects of a healthier life. The project is being funded by Freshwater Action Network, South Asia in collaboration with “End Water Poverty” & “Sanitation And Water For All”.

We support the GoI’s flagship programmes, which include the Swachh Bharat Mission, the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), WASH in Schools (including preschools called ‘Anganwadi), WASH in health facilities, and block-wide WASH interventions supporting planning and implementation and incorporating behaviour change into state and national guidelines and costed plans. Also, we are putting our knowledge and expertise in community-based issues regarding WASH to advocate and lobby.

In addition to that, GSP is contributing to menstrual hygiene management (MHM) in schools over recent years and the current momentum offers potential for even wider impacts.

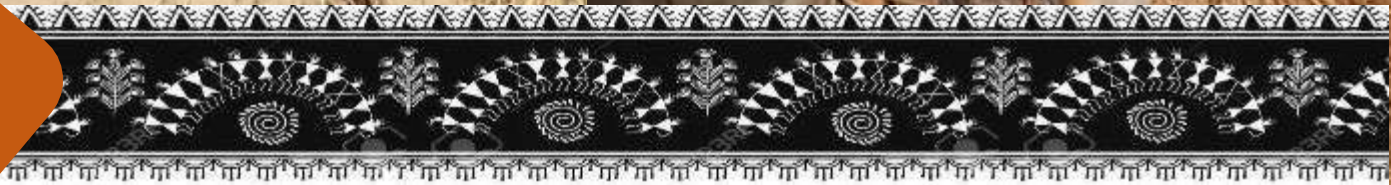


The reason behind the project initiation is, 22 per cent schools did not have appropriate toilets for girls, 58 per cent of preschools had no toilet at all, 56 per cent of preschools had no water on the premises, & 48% of drinking water sources in villages are not potable.

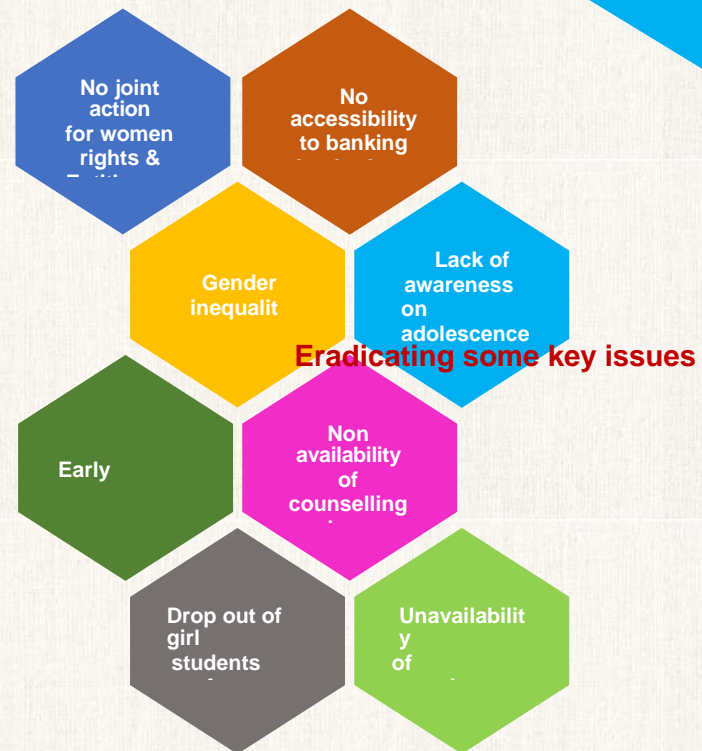




Transforming The Lives of Tribal Women in Nilgiri, Odisha



The project is backed by the Swiss League of Catholic Women SKF and it is being implemented in the Nilgiri block under Balasore district. The project already shaped hundreds of women entrepreneurs, who are making profits out of mushroom cultivation and spawn making, vegetable growing, spices packaging and marketing through fairs, exhibitions, etc. The success mantra of the project is grounded on an effective convergence model which has the elements of effectiveness, education relevance, stakeholders' engagement, involvement and sustainability involving GO, NGO, PRI and CBOs that has a reputation of bringing substantial improvement in empowering women, especially of the adolescent girls and women, in a collective form of cooperation and responsibilities. Key project activities are as follows-



Formation & Strengthening of WSHGs to promote it as a micro enterprises

Formation & training to adolescent girls groups on reproductive health, hygiene, gender discrimination and behavioural change

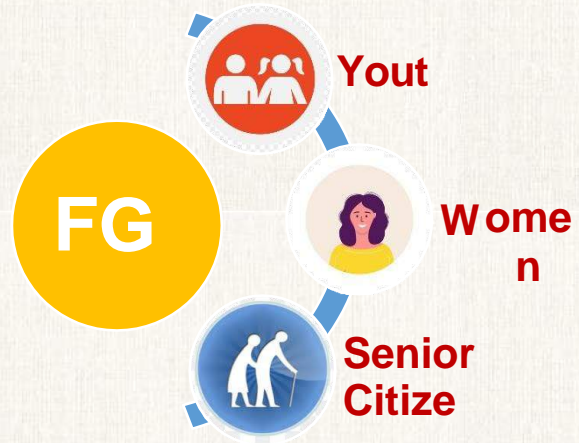
Input, technical & marketing support for promotion of kitchen garden and organic farming

Interface with officials of GO, NGO, PRI, for redressal of issues related to women and girls

The objective of the study is to assess the impact of digital banking on the general public. The study used an optimized approach to measurements (AMA) which allowed us to assess the operational risk involved in digital banking i.e. cyber fraud, processing errors, system disruptions, or other unanticipated events.



The study was conducted through focus group discussions with groups of youth, women, senior citizens and door to door surveys.

VILLAGE DISASTER MANAGEMENT PLAN



Project - Preparation of Village Disaster Management Plan in Ranpur Block of Nayagarh and Delang & Kanas Blocks of Puri District. Supported By – Odisha State Disaster Management Authority

In the present day, every individual is vulnerable and is threatened by natural and manmade disasters, which is growing in number and variety. In other words, every individual is required to be aware and also have the minimum capacity to counter such a crisis. This implies that the entire population of a village forms a community and has to be involved in its safeguard, as the first response to the natural hazards comes from the immediate neighborhood and spreads into the community, while the government and other organizations take some time to reach them.

The VDMP plan takes into account the status of the hazard history, vulnerability, infrastructure availability and institutional capacities. In accordance, it provides the procedures that may be implemented with immediate effect and subsequently upgrade as more resources become available and capacities of the stakeholders get built up. The immediate purpose is therefore to bring about the greater role clarity and coordination so that it gives the outline for mitigating future disasters.

The VDMP consists of operational context, preparedness, and response procedures which included the preparation of a Social Map, Resource Map, Vulnerability Map, Rescue and Rehabilitation Map, formation of Village Disaster Management Committee (VDMC) and Disaster Management Team. As of now, GSP has completed eighty VDMPs in 80 revenue villages of two districts in Odisha.

Our Response on Covid-19



GSP with its 20 years of experience in providing relief during disasters and delivering health programmes on the ground is well-positioned to support the affected citizens where the need is the greatest. GSP team has compiled all our learning and knowledge resources for ensuring that all of them are fully available to battle COVID 19.

In early 2020, during the Covid 19 breakout, GSP came out to support & protect the people from an adverse effect of Covid19 and organised series of activities to generate public awareness, safety measures training of volunteers, distribution of Covid safety materials, conducted a study on the impact of COVID-19 on PWDs and sanitation workers etc. The organisation worked for hand in hand with concerned district authorities of Koraput, Puri, and Malkangiri of Odisha.

- GSP distributed N95 Face masks, Medicated Soaps, Hand Sanitizers and IEC leaflets in Odia to create public awareness. This activity was carried out in Puri Sadar block of Puri district, Boipariguda block of Koraput district, and Khairiput block of Malkangiri districts in Odisha.

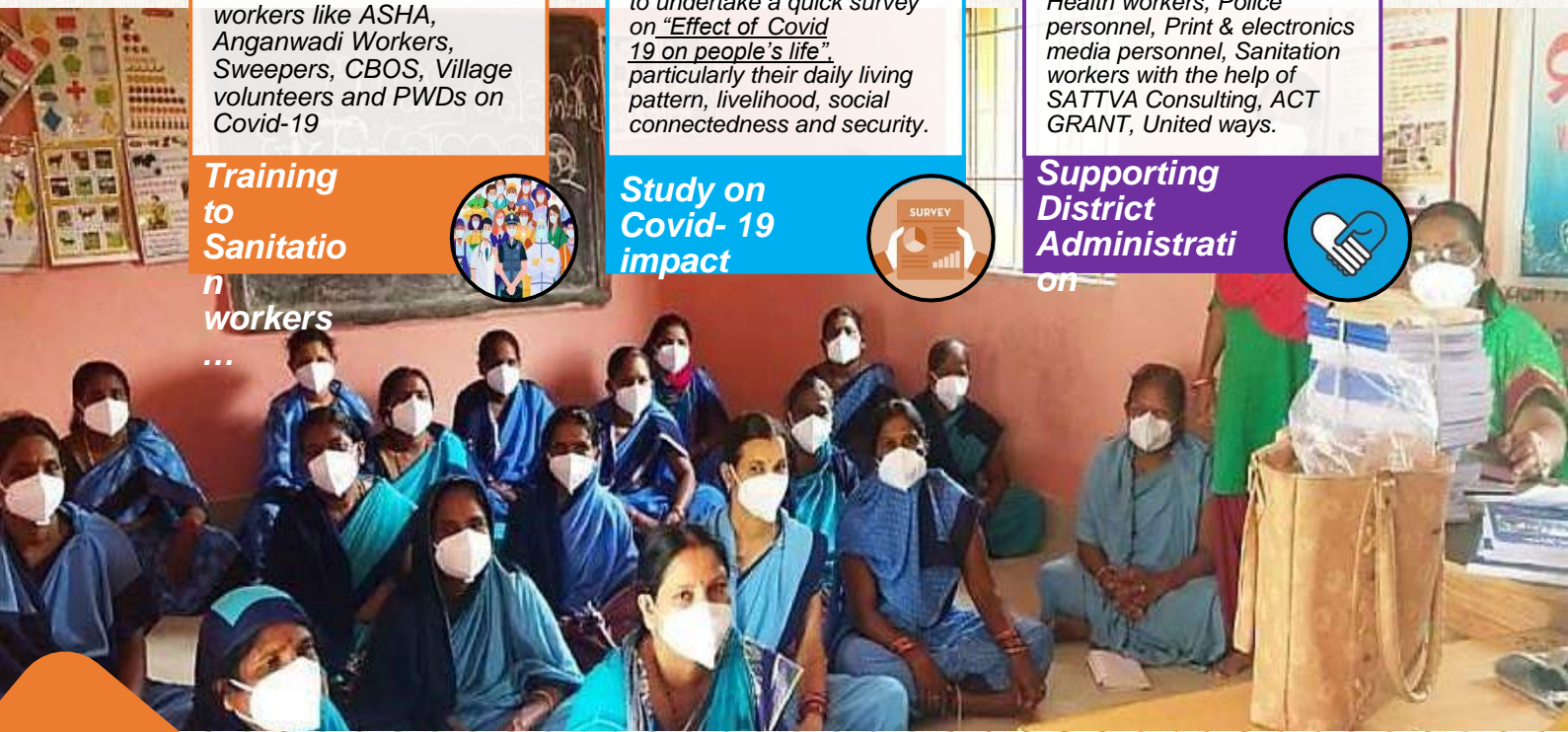


