INTRODUCTION:-



MISSION:-


To fight for the right of destitute women, orphan & marginal section of the community by establishing educational & vocational institutions.

- ❖ To organize youth camps 7 leadership training camps for the youth and to form action groups in villages.




- ❖ To develop medical facilities and to distributes medicines to people.
- ❖ To ensure welfare & family welfare of common persons through established camp.

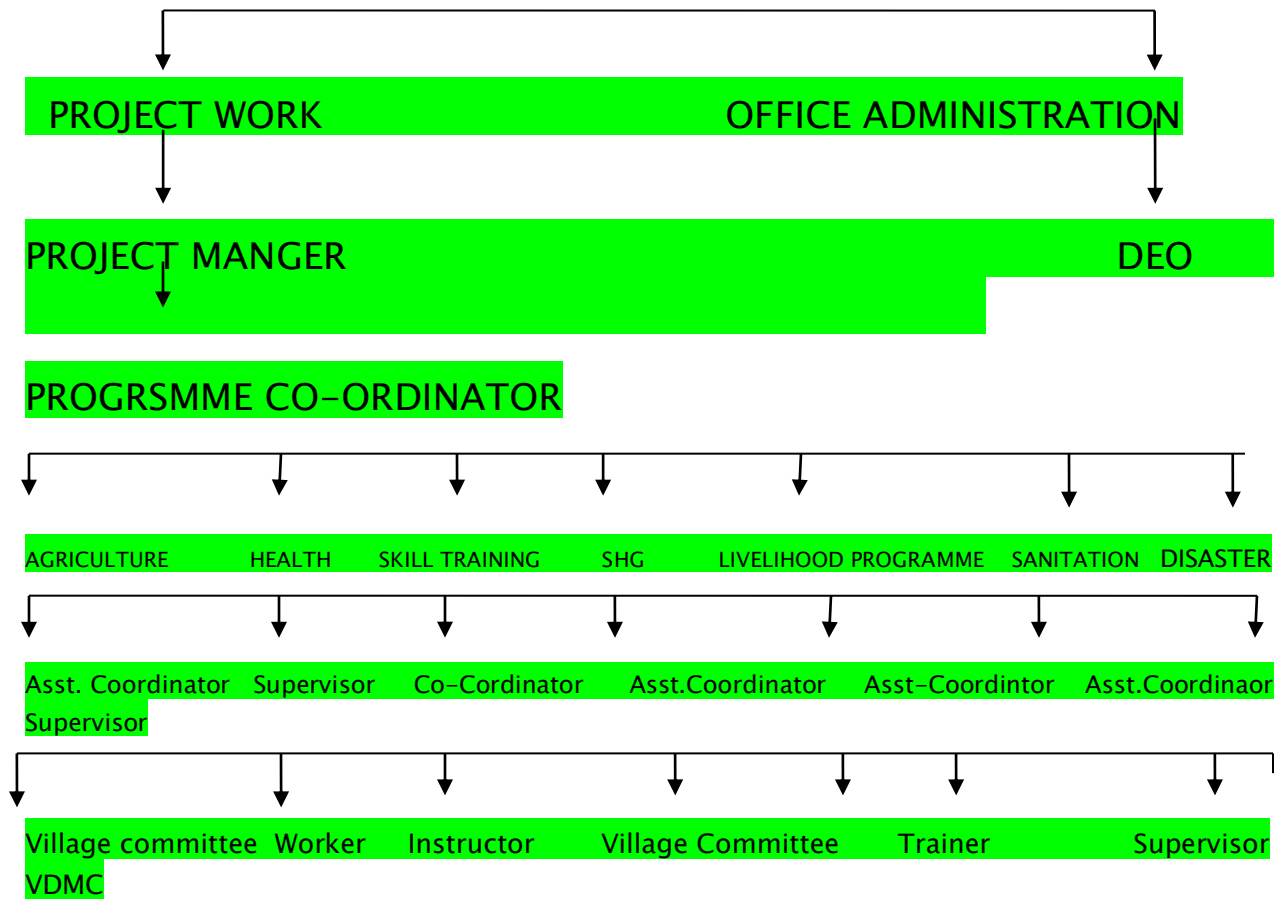
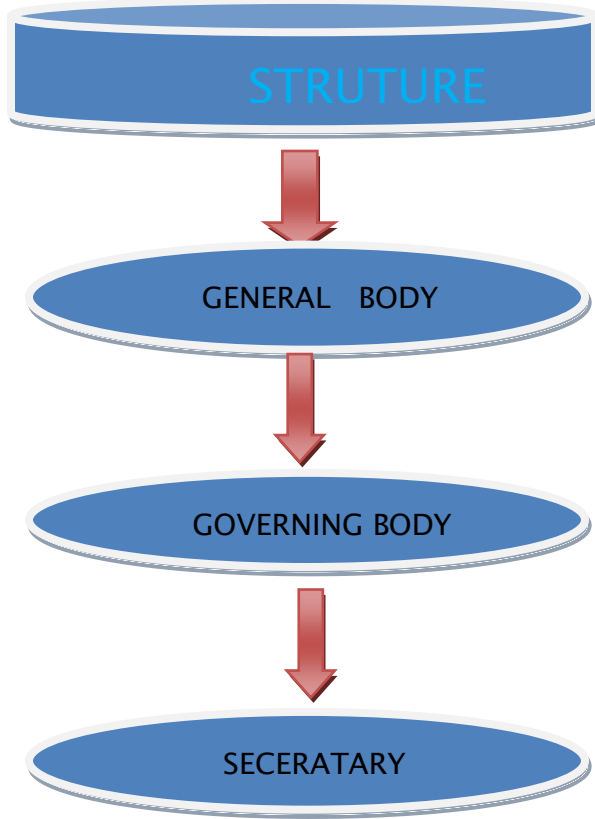
OPERATIONAL AREA:-



FUTURE PERSPECTIVES:-


- ❖ *To establish family council center.*
