- Running child labour school.

### 1. Running child labour school.

The Central Government has been initiated the "National Child Labour Project" (NCLP) to rehabilitate child labour in the country especially in backward districts with focus on rehabilitation of U14 children working in hazardous occupations and processes however, its main objectives are to eliminate all forms of child labour, withdrawal of all adolescent workers from hazardous occupations/processes and their skilling and integration in appropriate occupations & raising awareness amongst stakeholders and target communities. W.r.t based on area need we have been successfully running 50 children Child Labour School @ Gillesugur Camp with the financial support of Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. Of India & also district administration as well.



### 2. Celebration of national festivals.

Every year we proudly celebrate national festivals with lots of enthusiasm and pleasures and festivals are 15<sup>th</sup> August - Independence Day and 26<sup>th</sup> Jan - Republic Day and these vital events has been celebrated in our institution/Gillesugur camp with COVID protocol.



### 3. Distribution of study materials to poor students.

We have found in our action area due to poverty most of the parents were unable to send their children to schools and also are unable to provide uniform, text books, school bag and such other things which has been resulting school drop-outs. Hence we have distributed study materials to 20 poor students in Gillesugur camp especially those who are studying in Govt. schools and encouraged them to send their children to schools though there is pressing need to help more poor students for continuing their education.

### 4. Response COVID - 19.

The Corona Virus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by a new virus the disease causes respiratory illness with symptoms such as a cough, fever and in more severe cases & difficulty in breathing. The rapid spread of the Corona Virus Disease epidemic poses unprecedented challenges throughout the world especially under developing counties like India. Preventive measures to reduce the chances of infection include staying at home/social distancing, avoiding crowded places, washing hands with soap and water & wearing masks. So we have campaigned about pandemic issues & interventions, distributed free masks & also dry ration kits to needy in surrounding villages of Gillesugur camp with the support of local donors.



### **5. Supportive service for aged.**

As we knew all that senior citizens contribute their whole life to their descent and the country which is respected by the young generations. It's no doubt that the government and the next generation have the obligation and capability to raise the elderly people depending on the legislation and ethic. So we have extended possible support to 15 aged by distributing cloths & canes with the valuable support of local philanthropists/donors.
