They are the one who litters the destination. So awareness programs have to be conducted on a regular basis and strict actions have to be taken against those who are violating the laws. ‘Waste management using modern waste treatment plant’ etc for the management of degradable waste. For better result concrete waste bins have to be implemented and proper management has to be ensured. Camera has to be placed and properly monitored for taking actions against those who littering the destination.

Housekeeping (Cleaning) activities round O'clock every day by 60 labourers brought such visible changes, which rewarded Third Prize among the SIP status in our country at the National Level.



**2. Awareness Generation programme namely “APANA HAND PUMP AAP HI SAMBHALEN” supported by District administration (District Public Relation Office, Deoghar**

Mass awareness program was implemented through the “APANA HAND PUMP AAP HI SAMBHALEN” under Jal hi Jeevan Hai program and the mobile awareness method was initiated with showing the flag by Deputy Collector, Deoghar to move in all the 10 blocks covering 194 panchayats of Deoghar districts so that the people will get skilled to repair and maintain and handling the hand pump themselves. In case of problems going beyond the knowhow about it, the information based mechanism was readily made them available through the contact us given nos. of mason and the concerned authorities of the department.

Rarely people complain for the maintenance & handling of Hand Pumps in the areas concerned People themselves created water conservation measures in the form of Soak Pits construction and at least 578 cases of handling the hand pumps reported and now the people properly maintain and inspire the others also to do so in the rural areas.

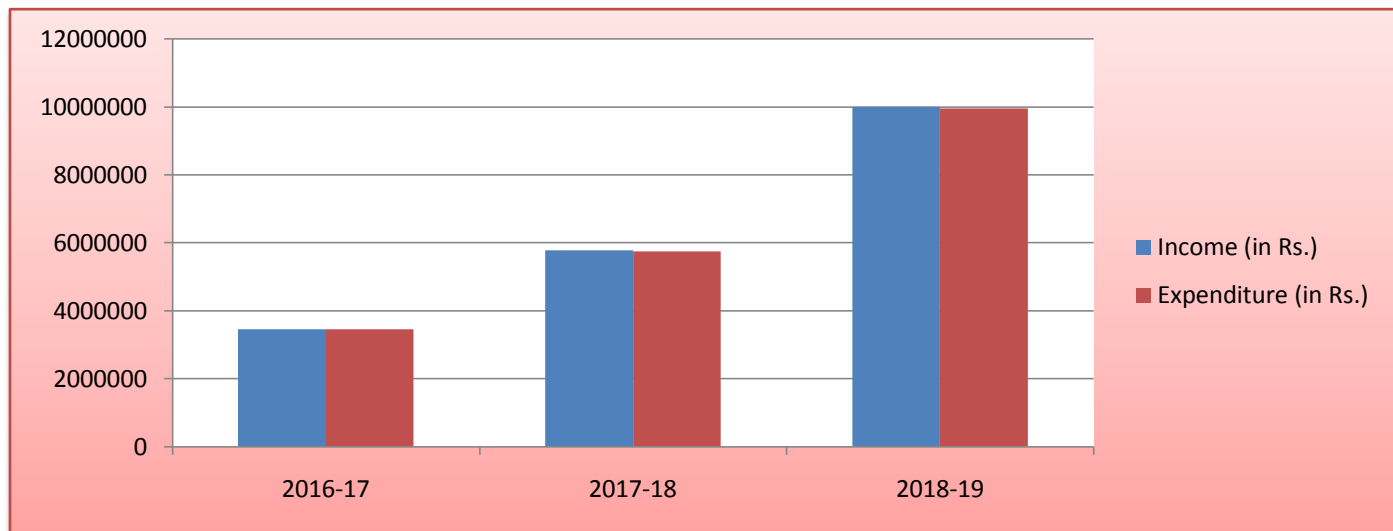
