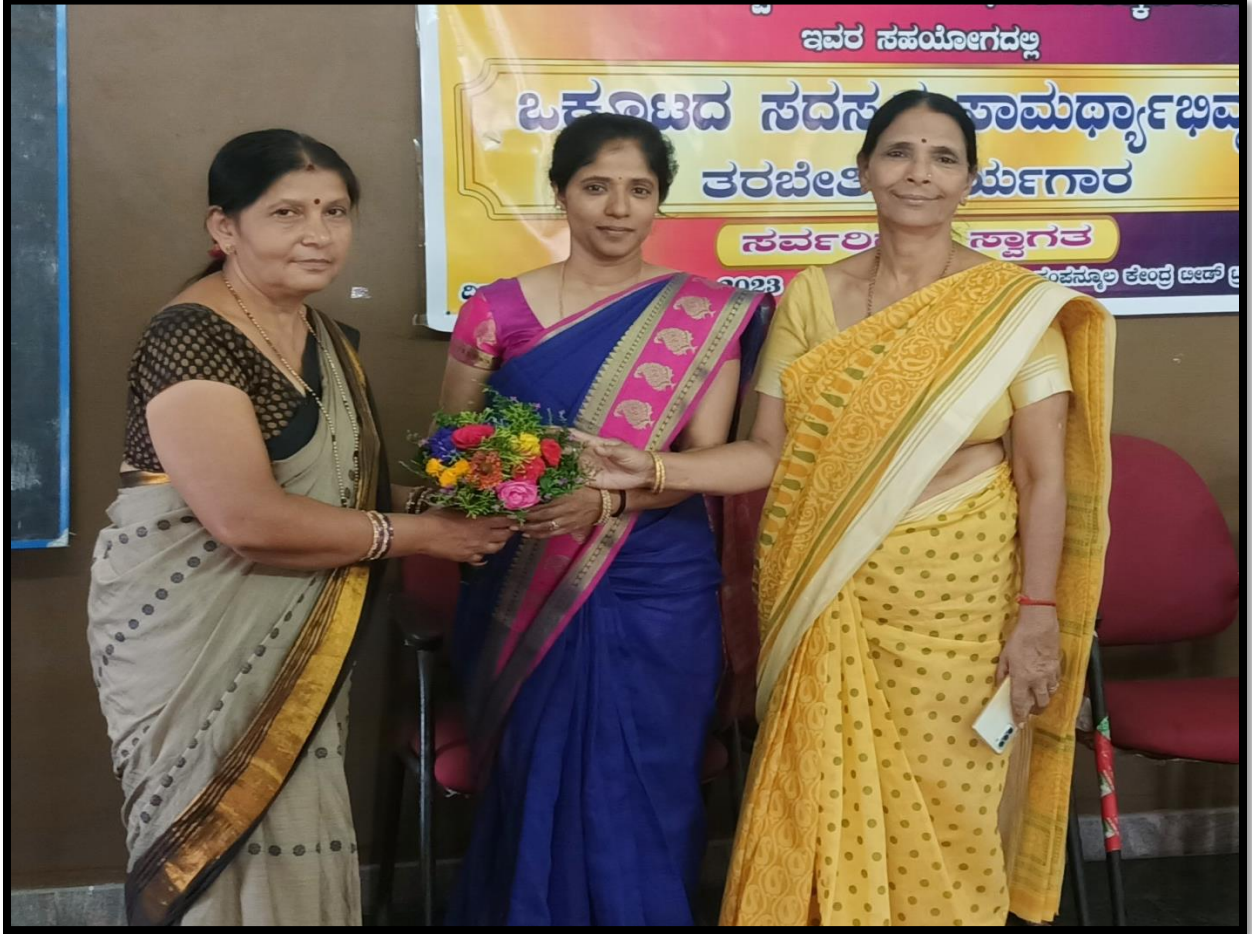

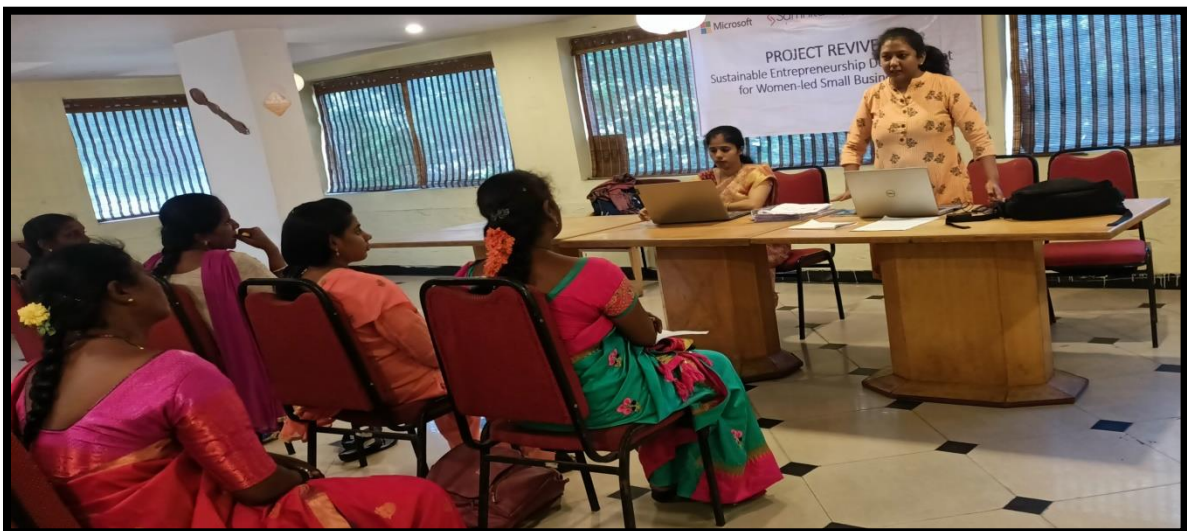
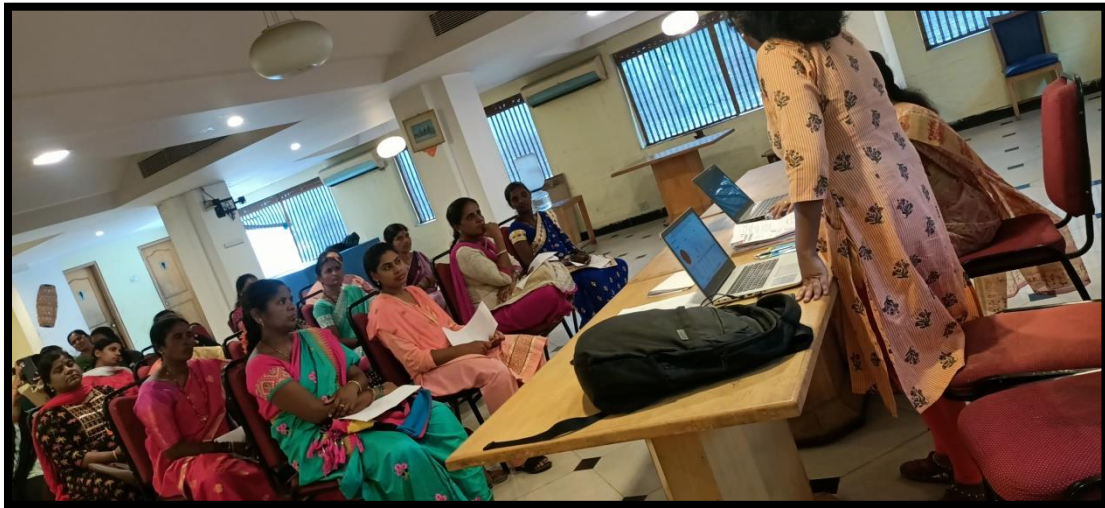
INCOME GENERATING ACTIVITY

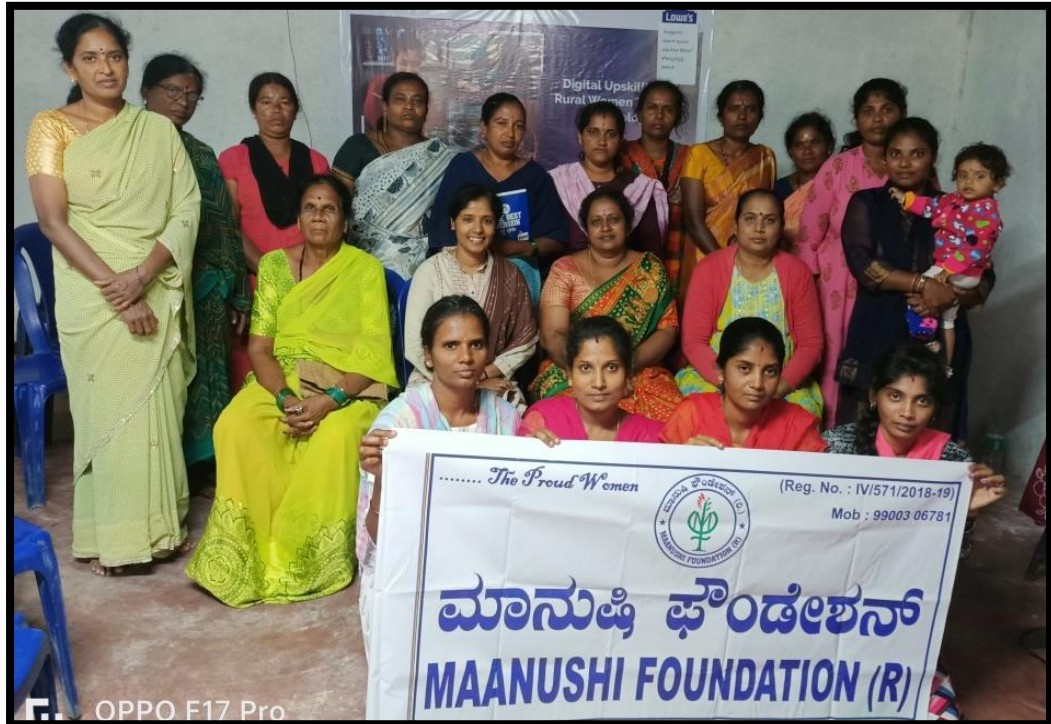

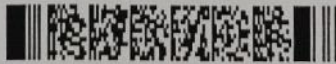
