One-Day Training Program on the "Prohibition of Child Marriage"

MANAB KALYAN successfully organized a one-day training program on the "Prohibition of Child Marriage" in collaboration with SIPRD Khanapara. The program was conducted in six senior secondary schools and colleges across the Darrang district. With the support of SIPRD funding, the event aimed to educate and empower young individuals about the harmful effects of child marriage and the importance of preventing such practices. The program saw an impressive turnout, with nearly 2,000 participants, including students and teachers from the participating institutions. The event's primary objective was to raise awareness about the legal and social implications of child marriage. Through interactive sessions, students and teachers were informed about the laws prohibiting child marriage and the steps they can take to address and prevent it within their communities.



The training program was well-organized and received enthusiastic participation. The presence of young individuals and educators highlighted the community's commitment to combating this significant social issue. The event served as a platform to inspire collective action against child marriage and to promote a safer and more equitable future for all children.



In this year the flood has affected about 21 villages of Achalpara, Batahidia Gaon panchayat. The peoples are facing many problems to survive their lives along with their cattle's. The scarcity of food, fodder and drinking water was the main challenges for their lives. With help of local peoples, we surveyed the affected villages and knew about their problems. The peoples lived in the highland and river embankment in temporary shelters in that period.

With the support of Ashraya Hastha Trust this year we provided cooked food and water bottles to the flood affected peoples for 5 days daily and covered above 5100 individuals



AWD Project

The project status in Darrang District involves approximately 7,000 farmers across multiple blocks and their respective villages. In **Bechimari Block**, the villages include Chukabahi, Daipam, Duliapara, Majgaon, Mousitha, and Shimaluguri. In **Dalgaon Block**, the villages are Badlichar, Bilpar, Barkur, KachomariSonari, Bholabari, Bhullichuba, and Borkhat. The **Kalaigaon Block** encompasses Barjhar, Begarkash, Bherbheri, Chenibari, Jhargaon, Nokhat, and No-1 Dhansiri. The **Majbat Block** includes the villages of Nomati, Chamuakhat, Dalgaon, Dhansrikash, Grandlandbagicha, Kehotali, and Ondolajhar. In **Pub Mangaldai Block**, the villages are Chalanikuchi, Chalardal, Dosotani, Garapari, Kacharibari, Kanmuji, and Sanowatari. Finally, the **Sipajhar Block** includes 2No Rajapukhuri, Rupahikash, Panbari, and Rajahowly. This initiative aims to directly impact and benefit the farmers in these regions, improving their livelihoods and agricultural practices.
