### **Purpose of KGBV School:**

According to the Census 2001, the Government of India identified 1500 Development Blocks as the most backward blocks in girl's education. In these blocks the percentage of women education is very low. Based on this data, in the year 2005, Government of India opened special schools in the name of "Kasturbha Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya(KGBV) School" for educating girl children who are dropout or unable to go to school for various reason. In Virudhunagar district of Tamilnadu Narikudi block was one of the most backward blocks in girl's education. In this block 3 KGBV schools were opened in the same year 2005, in Narikudi, Anaikulam and A.Mukkulam villages. Initially the strength of each school as 50 girls. The Narkudi KGBV school was sanctioned to our ODAM NGO and we are administering this school from 2005 to till date. Intheyear2009, this school wasupgradedandthestrengthofgirlswasincreasedto100. The purpose of this school is to stop the dropout of girl students and to develop the girl's education in the block. This school is conducted with the support of State and Central governments under the "Education to All" scheme.

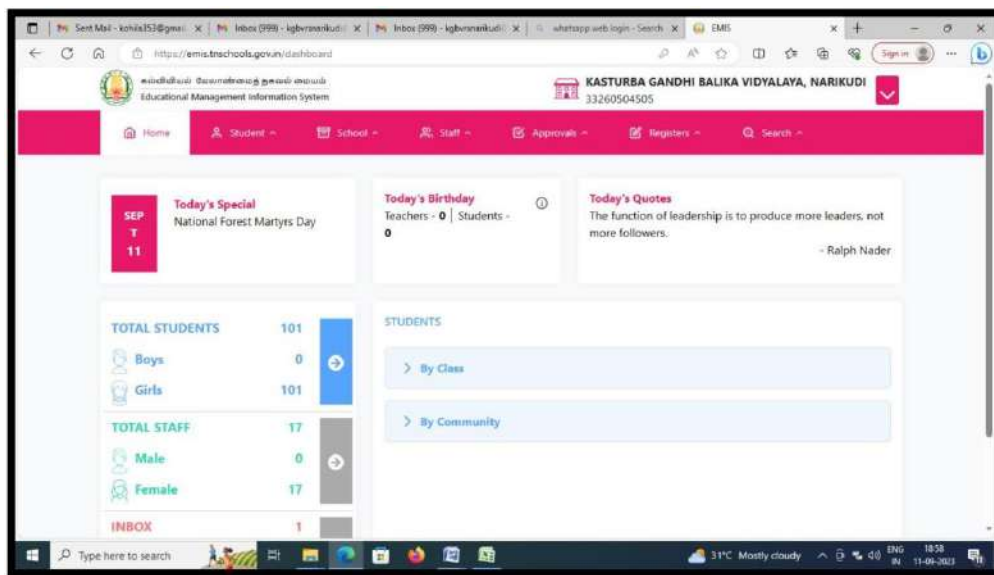


### **Salient features of the KGBV School:**

Our Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) school is residential upper primary schools for girls from disadvantaged communities, established under the Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) program. Here are the salient features of our ODAM - KGBV school

1. Residential School: KGBV school provides free residential facilities to girls from disadvantaged communities, enabling them to access quality education. One night watchman is appointed to ensure the safety and security of the girl students.

2. Upper Primary Education: KGBV school offers upper primary education (Classes VI - VIII) with a focus on academic excellence and holistic development.
3. 100% enrolment: Every year 100% enrolment of girl students is ensured in our KGBV school
4. Qualified teachers: Well qualified and experienced teachers are appointed for providing quality education. One night watchman is appointed to ensure the safety and security of the girl students in night.
5. Digital platform: Details of the all-girl students enrolled in KBV school are uploaded in RMIS portal of Education department.



6. Free Education and Facilities: KGBV school provides free education, uniforms, textbooks, all kinds of note books and other facilities to students. Also provided with suitable desks and benches in the class rooms.
7. Nutritious Meals: Students receive nutritious meals, ensuring their health and well-being. In morning and evening times they are given Horlicks, Boost, Padam milk, Nutritious flour, Payaru, Biscuit, vadai, rusk etc. They are given nutritious food for 3 times daily. Meat, chicken egg are also given. These items are provided according to the weekly menu. These foods are provided under the supervision of the procurement committee.
8. Cosmetics: All the students are provided with all the needed and essential cosmetic items every month.



9. Fireextinguisher: Fireextinguisherequipmentsareplaceinproperplacesoftheschooltoprotectthe students from fire accidents.
10. Incinerator: Incineratorisplacedforsafeandhygienicdisposalofsanitarynapkins.
11. Health and Hygiene: KGBV school prioritize health and hygiene, providing regular health check-ups and promoting sanitation practices.
12. LifeSkillsEducation: Studentsreceivelifeskillseducation,includingvocationaltraining,toempower them for future challenges.
13. Counseling: Onestaffistheretoprovidecounselingtoneededchildrenandtheirparents
14. ODAM NGO helps the VIII standard passed girl students to continue their education in mainstream schools and helps to get hostel facilities under RMSA scheme.
15. Trainings: The girl students are given training to attendNMMS , NAS examinations conducted by government.
16. Newspapers: To enhance the reading habit and to gain general knowledge 4 numbers of Tamil dailies and2 nos. of English dailies are purchased to the school and given to students.
17. Uniform dress: Every year the students are given school uniform dress, sports dress, chepels, shoes with sacs, petticoat, pillow, bed sheet, bucket with mugs on free of cost.
18. Recurring deposit (RD): RD account is opened in a nationalized bank in the name of each and every studentandeverymonthRs.200/-isdepositedinalloftheaccountsforthe purposeofmeetingexpensesto continue their higher education.
19. Procurement committee: Thiscommittee meetsevery monthand passresolutionto purchasegroceries, oil, vegetable and other essential items for the school and for the students. These things purchased with the consent of this committee.
20. Solar lamps: To get uninterrupted electricity solar system is erectedthrough SBGF.With this system solar lamps are fitted.
21. Community Engagement: KGBV school engages with local communities, promoting awareness aboutgirls' education and involving parents in the educational process.
22. Teacher-Student Ratio: KGBV school maintains a favorable teacher-student ratio, ensuring personalized attention and support for students.
23. Inclusive Education: KGBV school promotes inclusiveeducation, catering tothe diverse needs ofstudents, including those with disabilities.
24. Monitoring and Evaluation: The Tamil Nadu government regularly monitors and evaluates the KGBV school to ensure quality education and effective implementation.

### **Distribution of educational and supporting materials:**

In the reporting year 2023-2024, the Block Educational Officer Mr. Regunath, Mrs. Alamelumangai and BRC Superintendent Mr. Sundaramahalingam distributed Note books, text books and other educational materials to the KGBV students of free of cost.



### **Admission of Girl students:**

In the education year 2023-2024 the girl students' admission in the school was conducted within the time and without any interference. The girl students were admitted from Narikudi, Usilangulam, Pathanakurichi, Mosukudi, Melakudiyiruppu, Chittavannangulam, Parthibanur, Arungulam, Kulanthapuri, Salaiiluppakulam, Kuravaikulam, Mithilaikulam, Ambaneri villages. The admission was done as per the guidelines and procedures. The parents were given awareness about our schools' best services to girl students like providing quality education, quality food, best educational & supporting materials, best learning environment, super security and comfortable accommodation and keeping in mind these factors they sent their girl children to our KGBV school for getting better education to them.



**Distribution of Transfer Certificates (TC):**

The TCs were distributed to the girl's students who completed and passed in 8<sup>th</sup> standard in the educational year 21023-2024. The TCs were given by Narikudi Block Teacher Trainers, Mrs. Mrs. Rajalakshmi, and Mrs. Mehala, on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023.



**Prizes distribution:**

As an encouragement to our KGBV school and our girl students Mrs. Rajalakshmi, Teacher Trainer, Narikudi Block Resource Center(BRC), distributed gift box containing other writing materials to our school and to our girl students.



### **Book Festival:**

The second annual Book Fair was conducted in Virudhunagar. In this book show various books, magazines, and reading materials were exhibited. Our KGBV school girl students and teachers participated in this book fair. They visited the books and selected for reading. This book fair encouraged and enhanced their reading capacity. The ancient things brought from the archeological area near Vembakkottai were exhibited in the book fair. The students saw these things and knew about the ancient civilization of Tamilnadu. Also the girl students visited the various kinds of musical instruments exhibited in the fair.



### **Yoga Day:**

Yoga was introduced by a saint named Pathanjali. In our KGBV school the girls were given Yoga training by a lady Yoga Master Mrs. Umadevi, from Pranic Healing Centre Aruppukkottai. Yoga is necessary for everyone for healthy living. Our students learned yoga from the master and were able to demonstrate it well. Our students demonstrated yoga types like padmasanam, vajrasanam, Utkattasanam, SooriyaNamaskaram, Halasanam etc.



### Education Development Day:

On the occasion of birth day of Mr. Kamarajar, the King maker of India, Former CM of Tamilnadu, Education development day as celebrated in our KGBV school. On this day students ere explained about the initiatives taken by Mr. Kamaraj for development of education in Tamilnadu. He opened thousands of schools in rural villages and provided opportunities to village children to study in the schools. Competitions were conducted and prizes were distributed to the winners.



### IndependenceDay:

On 15<sup>th</sup> August Independence Day as celebrated in our KGBV school. The main aims of this programme is to commemorate India's Independence Day and pay tribute to the nation's freedom fighters, to instill patriotism and nationalism among students, to promote unity and diversity among students. The School Secretary Mrs. V. Vasantha hoisted the national flag and talked about the freedom fighters and their sacrifices. The Block superintendents of Narikudi and Kadaladi block, Teacher trainers, ODAM Australia volunteers also participated in the celebration. Competitions related to independence day, freedom fighters were conducted and prizes were distributed to the winners. At the end of the programme sweets were given to the children.



### Teachers' day:

Teachers' Day was celebrated in our school on 5th September 2023. The main aim of this programme is to honor the dedication and hard work of our teachers. The HM of this school delivered a heartfelt message, emphasizing the importance of teachers in shaping the future of students. The students felicitated their teachers with bouquets, cards, and gifts, expressing their gratitude for their guidance and support. Teachers participated in various games and activities, including a quiz competition, treasure hunt, and musical chairs.

### **Patriots' and Sacrificer's Day:**

**Stafftrainings:****a. CRCtraining:**

The three-day training program on Child Rights Convention (CRC) was conducted in BRD, Narikudi and attended by 7 teachers from Narikudi ODAM KGBV school. The training was facilitated by BRC superintendent, a renowned expert on child rights and CRC. The aim of this training programme was promoting awareness and understanding of child rights and responsibilities among teachers. The training employed a participatory approach, including: Interactive lectures and discussions, Group activities and role-plays, Case studies and scenario-based learning, Reflective journaling and self-assessment.

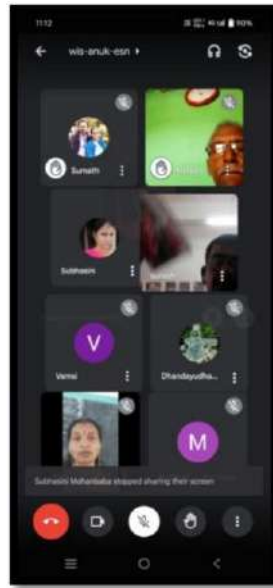
**RP Training:**

The training reinforced the importance of effective classroom management, behavioral skills, and teaching-learning materials in enhancing student learning.



### **HealthrelatedAwarenessprogrammes:**

#### **a. NationalNutritionmonthprogramme:**

National Nutrition Month as observed to promote awareness and education on healthy life. In this programme a nutrition awareness campaign was launched, where students, teachers, and parents were educated on healthy eating habits, nutrition, and wellness through posters, banners, and leaflets. Also a healthy food exhibition was conducted, where students showcased healthy food items, including fruits, vegetables, whole grains, and lean proteins.



**b. Malaria Eradication Awareness Programme:**

On 26<sup>th</sup> June 2023, this programme was conducted in our KGBV by the Health team of Narikudi Primary Health Center (PHC). The aim of this programme was to promote awareness and to conduct education on malaria prevention, control, and eradication among KGBV students, teachers, and community members. In this programme the doctor spoke about malaria transmission, symptoms, prevention, and control measures. Also students and teachers were educated on malaria prevention and control measures, including use of insecticide-treated bed nets, indoor residual spraying, and prompt treatment of malaria cases. At the end of the programme Students, teachers, and community members took a malaria awareness pledge, promising to promote malaria prevention and control measures in their communities.



**c. National TB Eradication Awareness Programme:**

This programme was conducted successfully, promoting awareness and education on TB prevention, control, and eradication among KGBV students, teachers, and community members. The programme reinforced the importance of collective efforts in preventing and controlling TB.



**d. First Aid and Disaster Management Training:**

The objective of this programme was creating awareness and preparedness for emergency situations among KGBV school teachers and students. The training reinforced the importance of first aid and disaster management in saving lives and reducing the impact of disasters. This programme was conducted by Mr. C. Narikudi block level Cultural festival was conducted at Narikudi on 20-10-2023 to provide a platform for students to showcase their talents, traditions, and cultural heritage. ### **Clubs and their functions:**

#### **a. Tamil & English Club:**

To develop the Maths skills among the students, maths club activities are conducted in last week of every month. The students select leaders and members of this club among themselves. The HM and math teacher conducted this club activities. This club activities facilitated the students to develop various maths skills among them.



#### **c. Science Club:**

The School Science Club has been successful in promoting scientific awareness, curiosity, and innovation among students. The club's activities have helped to develop critical thinking, problem-solving, innovation, and analytical skills, and have increased interest and enthusiasm for science among students. The HM and Science teacher conducted this club activities.



#### **Environmentclub:**

The School Environment Club has been successful in promoting environmental awareness, conservation, and sustainability among students. The club's activities have helped to develop leadership and teamwork skills, and have contributed to a cleaner and greener school environment. The HM and Social science teacher conducted the club activities.



#### **Skilldevelopment:**

##### **a. SummervacationeducationTraining:**

In Virudhunagar district the disyctic collector has ordered to conduct special education training to the KGBV school girls students in various places. Five of our students studying in VIII standard were selected for summer vacation education training conducted inPalyampatti Teacher Training Institute on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023. This training was very useful to the students understand abvbour higher studies .



**b. Spoken English training:**

This training was conducted for 2 weeks by ODAM Australia Volunteers Mrs. Cheri Smith & Mrs. Tamara. Objective of this spoken English Training program was to improve the spoken English skills of KGBV girl students, enhancing their communication skills and confidence. The volunteers conducted the training in the undermentioned methodologies:

- Interactive sessions with role-plays, group discussions, and debates
- Language games, puzzles, and activities to improve vocabulary and grammar
- Audio-visual aids, including videos and podcasts, to enhance listening skills

This program's interactive and engaging methodology helped students build confidence and improve their communication skills.



### **Educational Quiz:**

The educational quiz was conducted in our school on 9<sup>th</sup> August 2023. The Educational Quiz was a success, achieving its objective of promoting learning, healthy competition, and teamwork among KGBV students. The quiz helped identify areas where students need improvement and provided a platform for students to showcase their knowledge. The observations in the programme are as follows:

### **c. Train/Bus Ticket-Online Booking Training:**

This training was conducted to our school students by the Computer Teacher in our school premises. In this training students gained hands-on experience in booking train and bus tickets online, improved digital literacy and confidence among students in using online platforms like Google etc., enhanced independence to them in planning and booking travel.



### **Home science training:**

This programme was conducted in our school under the title "Let us start fresh". This programme equipped KGBV students with essential home science skills, promoting self-sufficiency, health, and hygiene.



### **SEAS Examination:**

The SEAS (Science, English, Aptitude, and Scholarship) Examination was conducted on 02-10-2023 to 6<sup>th</sup> standard students to assess the knowledge and skills of students in science, English, and aptitude, and to identify talented students for scholarships and further opportunities. Observations of the programme: Students demonstrated a good understanding of science and mathematics concepts, English language skills need improvement, Aptitude skills showed a mixed trend.

The meeting helped to identify areas for improvement and resolve issues related to school infrastructure and facilities.



### Procurement committee meeting:

This meeting was conducted on 31.07.2023 in our school campus. In this meeting School Secretary Mrs. V.Vasantha, Narikudi BRC Superintendent Mr. Sundaramahalingam, Maruthupandiyar GHS School HM Mr. Thandeeswaran, Hostel Warden, Accountant, Teacher Trainers participated in the meeting. The Procurement Committee Meeting was conducted successfully, in reviewing and approving procurement plans, orders, and bids. The meeting ensured that procurement processes are transparent, accountable, and efficient.



### Eye camp:

Free Eye Camp was conducted with an objective, to provide comprehensive eye care services to KGBV students, teachers, and local community members, promoting eye health and vision care. In this eye camp Dr. Ramesh, (Ophthalmic Assist) GPHC Narikudi and his team conducted the screening tests to the participants especially to our school students. In this eye camp 100 students, teachers, and community members received free eye examinations and the following 9 girl students received free spectacles:

**Anemia awareness:**

The objective of the Anemia Awareness program was to educate KGBV students about the causes, symptoms, and prevention of anemia, promoting healthy lifestyles and in taking of iron-rich diets. Program Contents: Definition and types of anemia, Causes and symptoms of anemia, Importance of iron-rich diet and healthy lifestyle, Prevention and treatment of anemia, personal hygiene and importance and necessity of in-taking of Iron Folic tablets. The students were advised to take WIFS Tablets once in a month. This awareness programme was conducted by Mrs. V.Dhanalakshmi, VHN and Mrs. A.Muthuirulayee, SHN from PHC Narikudi.

**RBSK Health camp:**

The main motto of the RBSK (Rashtriya BalSwasthya Karyakram) Health Camp was to provide comprehensive health screening and referral services to KGBV students, promoting early detection and management of health conditions. This programme was conducted in our KGBV school by the medical team from Narikudi PHC. All the students were checked up and provided treatments to the needy children. Details of services provided in this health camp: General health check-up, Anthropometric measurements (height, weight, BMI), Vision testing, Hearing testing, Dental examination, Referral services for further treatment.



### **Boomi Pooja:**

Boomi Pooja was conducted in our school to construct new toilets for students and teachers. In this function, School Secretary V.Vasantha, Teacher Trainer Mr. Rajasekar, school teachers and students participated. The Engineer team and masons conducted this boomi pooja in a grand manner.



### **Incentive giving:**

School Secretary Mrs. V.Vasantha distributed the bank pass books to all the students studied in the year 2022-2023. Government incentive amount is credited in these bank pass books. The amount of incentive is Rs. 200/- per month per student. The students can utilize this incentive amount to pursue higher education



### **Children Movies:**

The objective of the children's movie screening was to provide KGBV school students with a recreational and educational experience, promoting social and emotional learning.



### **Talentia-2024**

During Talentia 2024 celebration our students exhibited their subject related art works and crafts. The exhibition was inaugurated by Block Educational officer, BRC Superintendent and School Secretary by lighting a kuthuvilakku.



### **EducationTour:**

To encourage the girl students of our KGBV school, the District Collector granted permission for 2 day education tour to Kodaikanal, a well-known hill station. The aim of this education tour was to provide KGBV school students with a unique learning experience, promoting experiential learning, team building, and cultural enrichment. The students visited Solar Observatory, Museum, Pillar Rocks, Guna Caves, and Berijam Lake. Students learned about the geography, climate, and ecosystem of Kodaikanal. During this tour the children had enjoyed fun, relax and entertainment.



**DIET Professor visit:**

On 17<sup>th</sup> June 2023 the District Institute for Education and Training (DIET) Professor Mr.Velladurai visited our school and gave his valuable suggestions for effective functioning of our KGBV school and providing quality education to the girl students. He accompanied by The BRC superintendent and Narikudi block Teacher Trainers.



**Chief Educational Officer (CEO) visit:**

Mr. Raman, CEO, Virudhunagar district visited our school. He inspected the classrooms, hostel, cooking place, office room and play ground. He also inspected the registers and record of the school and told that the safety of girl students is very important and it must be ensured in all ways.



**District Project Officer visit:**

During his visit the District Project Officer observed that the school has made significant progress in terms of infrastructure development and academic performance. However, they also identified areas that require improvement, including: Infrastructure improvement, and Teacher's Trainings.



**Block Education Officer (BEO):**

The BEO visited the school and interacted with teachers and students about the school progress. He asked questions among the students that they need any other facilities or amenities for their convenient study.



**Stationary Auditor visit:**

The school management is committed to implementing the Inspector's recommendations to ensure a healthy and safe environment for students and staff.



### **Building Engineer visit:**

The Building Engineer visited our school to inspect the school's infrastructure, including buildings, classrooms, laboratories, and other facilities, and to identify areas for repair, maintenance, and upgrading.
