We are also working on HIV/AIDS supported by Jharkhand State Aids Control Society and National AIDS Control Organization and serving more than 750+ Female Sex Workers and their health related problems and provide them the facilities are:

1. Free Condom Services to FSW
2. Community Based Screening facility to test HIV/AIDS at FSW's Doorsteps
3. ICTC and TB tests to reduce the risk on life.
4. PLHIV's linkage to ART and Medicine service to their Doorstep.

5. Promotion of HIV/AIDS Control and Prevention ACT-2017
6. Pension and other government schemes are facilitating to PLHIV's
7. VDRL, Viral Load Test and CD4 test of PLHIV's

Weekly Review Meeting

Prabha Bharti is an organization that believes in unanimous consent and group participation and hence weekly review meeting has been planned. In this review meeting work all staffs reviewed and if any hurdle occurs in any stage was resolved by the competent authority.



DIC Meeting

DIC meeting or Drop in Centre meeting is planned for the Peer Educators and HRGs. In this meeting their issues are discussed and as a response agency Prabha Bharti tries to resolve that.

Health Camp

As Prabha Bharti working on Prevention and Control of HIV/AIDS under the aegis of JSACS and NACO and is completely associated with health of humane, and henceforth free health camps for public welfare are organized. We in this camp provide health Check-up, medicine facilities, counseling and HIV/AIDS screening. We also suggest the public attends out health



camp to visit our office for more services and information.

Advocacy Meeting

Advocacy is the process to represent any issue or problems of society, raising voice against miscellaneous act or creating pro public society. Prabha Bharti as a development agency tries to do the same as above said through its Advocacy Meeting. Local leaders, Gram Pradhans,



Stakeholders, Advocates and people from communities are invited in this meeting where hurdles that occurs or faced by HRGs, Communities, Peer Educators or any needy person are discussed and best way to resolve that are approached.

Community Based Screening beyond Catchment Area Camp

Community Based Screening is method through which Outreach Worker screen for HIV/AIDS of HRGs. Testing kit was provided by JSACS/NACO and areas that are not covered or areas that are beyond the catchment area of TI-Prabha Bharti was selected for the screening HIV/AIDS.

Stakeholder Meeting

Stakeholders are encouraged through stakeholder meeting to participate more on awareness program, help deprived HRGs to get facilitated for their needs etc. Stakeholders are an important part of our program and through this meeting we try to connect and appreciate them for their priceless contribution.

Clinic facility

All the registered HRGs are ensured clinic facility and for that Prabha Bharti has hired their own doctor. As HRGs are the target group of this project and Prabha Bharti is bound to serve them the best services. Henceforth, clinic facilities for HRGs better



health are provided.

Mid Media Program

Mid Media program is an awareness program organized for the Migrants to aware them about HIV/AIDS, Prevention and Control of HIV/AIDS and the myth that spread over public domain in the absence of proper information.

Demand Generation Meeting

This is organized by the outreach worker among the HRGs. Purpose of conduction this meeting is to enquire about the needs of HRGs such as need of condoms, STI treatment, medicines, health facilities etc. and 5 meeting for five hotspots are being organized every month.

And beyond these listed activities we also create pro people environment to eliminate inequality, gender discrimination etc.

Some of the activities are

1. AIDS Day awareness campaign
2. Awareness on HIV Act, 2017
3. Rural visit and awareness program on myth of AIDS
4. Crisis Management and legal support program for HRGs etc.



Swadhar Greh

Since 4th April 2020, Prabha Bharti is serving 31 beneficiaries in it Swadhar Greh and out of these 31 beneficiaries, 24 have been sent to their home after counseling and other formalities. Two of them were connected with livelihood under the swadhar scheme. We also provide skill development training as per the ability of the women comes to our Swadhar Greh. During corona period, about 101 females were served with health facilities and food grains. Volunteers of Swadhar Greh not only had shown their duty but also humanity by donating blood to the needy.



Our team also works for the resilience and aware women for their rights. Protects victimized women and fights for their rights too.

Swadhar Greh's main objective is to protect and shelter victimized women, provide legal aid, counseling, and fix their issue with legal action. We also work for the reduction of violence against women, and to link them with mainstream.

Under the scheme of swadhar greh, we also provide different benefits to empower women and are-

1. Legal Aid
2. Health Facilities
3. Education and Skill Development
4. Counseling
5. Awareness on right of women
6. Shelter
7. Food
8. Clothing

Case study

Suman Soni, 24 years, wife of Shera Soni with their two kids of age 2years and infant were sent to Swadhar Greh Deoghar by Mahila Thana, Deoghar. They were lost and searching for help. During the counseling, Suman uttered that her husband is drunker. He often drinks and beats them. The day when



they lost, her husband beated them badly, left them alone and ran away. She was broken inside and thought of never back home and took a train from nearby station. She was with their kids and helpless when one lady offered her help in the train. Because of need she accepted her help and moved with her. Later she does not feel comfortable and decided to move from there. She again took a train and reached to Jasidih, Deoghar. Where being suspect Mahila Police Officers caught her and took to Police station where she explained all her problems. After all the formalities, mahila thana surrendered her to Swadhar Greh.



She spoke about the extramarital affair of her husband and the main cause of his in-human activity while counseling at Swadhar. Her poor background and her husband's demand for money were also disturbing her mentally.

After counseling she provided her contact details and address later. Our team did a great job, they contacted her in laws and mother's house, called them Swadhar Greh, Deoghar and aware them of the hurdle she faced.

Bal Mela

On 14/11/2020, Narangi Panchayat of Saakha Block with coordination of Prabha Bharti, Baal Mela was organized where 128 participants were participated.

This Baal Mela was inaugurated by the chief guest and Gram Pradhan Mrs. Premlata Devi. She also praised the event and encouraged whole team for the same. Such kind of events generates activeness and helps in proper growth among children said by her. She also requested the team members to organize such events in regular interval basis.

Child Marriage Act legal Training

One day training program on 08/09/2020 was organized by Prabha Bharti on child marriage in the premises of Panchayat Bhawan, Baijukura panchayat and was inaugurated by lighting the lamp by MRs. Usha Devi, President, Panchayat Samiti. This training was attended by the youngsters of 3 panchayats and the total attendees were of 53.

Secretary of Prabha Bharti welcomed all the participants present there and aware them about child marriage. In her speech, she spoke about how to stop it? And why child marriage shouldn't be done? Marriage that happens under 18 years (for girls) and 21 years (for boys) age are considered as child marriage though, it is done by the consent of boys or girls.

To stop such illegal practices legal rights have been given by the law of India to the society and do not needed anyone's permission to stop child marriage. As a responsible citizen of India, it becomes our duty to report such practices nearby police station or administration.



Member of this event Madhu Kumari further expressed the key point "why child marriage should stop?" and are-

1. Child marriage exploits child rights
2. Risk of Maternal Mortality remains high
3. High Risk Child/infant Mortality

4. Poor health and vulnerability
5. Lack of education etc.

And Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 says child marriage is a crime and there is a provision of 2 years of jail or 1 lac of fine to those involves themselves in child marriage.

Celebration of Women's Day

On 8/03/2020, by the aegis of Prabha Bharti, International Women's Day was celebrated in the premises of National Campus School, Court Road B. Deoghar. This event was inaugurated by lighting the lamp by the chief guest Deputy Commissioner Mr. Manjunath Bhajanrti. He introduced his idea of women empowerment and triggered the females present there for their own livelihood. Livelihoods that women can choose are of various types and are easily affordable with least investment. Housewives can opt for organic plate making, donga making, agarbatti making and solar lights etc. if the SHGs come forward for organic plate making, administration will provide them plate making machine. This will help the women being economic sufficient and empowered enough to invest their own earning.



He also uttered that the best way to become empowered is to be educated. Education is the only way that empowers everyone SOCIALLY, ECONOMICALLY, PHYSICALLY. Also women present there were encouraged especially to send their girls to school and get education.

Thematic street play was performed by the volunteers of Prabha Bharti and aware the crowd about the importance of education and BETI BACHAO, BETI PADHAO's motto.

Some other program such as Domestic Violence Act, 2005, Constitutional rights to women, physical abuse or harassment were organized and appealed the participants to raise their voice against any malpractices that happens intentionally or unintentionally to hamper their identity.

Agricultural and Livelihood Program

One day training program on 05/06/2020 on agriculture was organized and this program was inaugurated by lighting the lamp by Mukiya Mrs Premlata Devi. Resource person of this event Mr. Raja Ram Jee trained the farmers present their about making of vermicompost. Also they were taught How to use it? They were too trained about the cultivation of sri-vidhi and it better production. Some other



important crops were too discussed in this training program. Major focus area of this training program was to encourage the farmers, aware them about new technologies, way to better production and mix farming.

Kitchen garden, an idea that reduces water wastage and how this idea helps in growing crops were also delivered to the audience there.

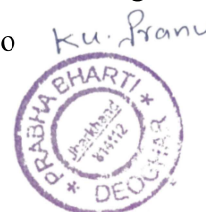
At the end of this program, Secretary, Prabha Bharti distribute seeds to the farmers for their kitchen garden and the program ended here.

present there about the importance of SHG formation, benefits and how it leading to women empowerment. SHG members were trained on management of accounts, record keeping, meeting



planning, equality and right uses of money they are borrowing from the group, importance of transparency and unbiased distribution of loan.

Not only financial part but health related issues, domestic issues, use of money, etc. were discussed there. They were encouraged to raise their voice against problems and participate more in decision making to be in the mainstream.
