Genesis

The founding directors of the Sustain Savvy Research Foundation, after completing their master's degrees in plant sciences in 1996, dedicated nearly two decades to working with tribal and rural farming communities with M. S. Swaminathan Research Foundation under the mentorship of Bharat Ratna (Prof.) M. S. Swaminathan and Padmashree (Dr.) Ajay Parida. Following the deaths of both mentors, the directors decided to establish the Section-8, not-for-profit organisation to continue their mentors' work in food, nutrition, health, and livelihood security for rural and tribal communities in India. The foundation aligns with the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals and adheres to guidelines from NITI Aayog and other policy think tanks.
