3) General Body and Other Meetings:

- a) A General Body Meeting of the Society will be held every year during the months of June to August.

 - c) A Committee from the coming year shall be elected in the General Body Meeting.

5) Account :

 - b) The Assets and liabilities and the Auditor's Balance Sheet of the Association shall be laid before the Annual General Body Meeting for confirmation.
 - c) Such Balance Sheet and the list of committee members be filed with Register of Societies as per Section 13 of the K.S.R. Act. 1960.
- 6) **Auditor:** An Auditor shall be appointed annually and the remuneration shall be fixed by the Annual General Meeting.

7) Executive Committee :

- a) To ensure and promote the Primary aims and objects of the society.
- b) To operate funds and manage the property of the society and to present the duly audited accounts at the Annual General Meeting.
- c) To Publish Annual Report and Account
- d) To from branches of Regional Centers wherever deemed fit/feasible as per cause (9)

- e) In the event of any office bearer lying down office for whatever reasons, the Managing Committee can co-opt any Member considered suitable for the office for the retraining period of the tenure or till next elections is held.

- 15) The Executive Committee in its meeting shall consider all the questions affecting business, that may be of interest to the members of the association and they shall inform and circulate any information which may be use and beneficial to the members.
- 16) Alterations or amendment to the memorandum of Association or Rules and Regulations shall be made as per Section 9 of the K.S.R. Act 1960.
