THENDRAL is a Tamil word meaning "BREEZE" and THENDRAL is the abbreviated form of "The Holistic Eagerly Nature Development Related Alternative Life". The purpose is to serve humanity through the concept of Back to Nature.

On a road to globalization with rapid changes in the technological growth, people are alienated from balanced social life. Despite the growth in technological aspects, many social evils still persist and unaddressed. In this scenario, service to the humanity has acquired relevance. It demands equipped people to meet the challenges of life so that it will help them contribute their share in healing some of the social imbalances. THENDRAL's sole purpose is to uplift victims from their miserable conditions caused by social imbalances. Founded in 2004, Thendral Movement Trust is committed to **women's empowerment, child development, and community rehabilitation.**

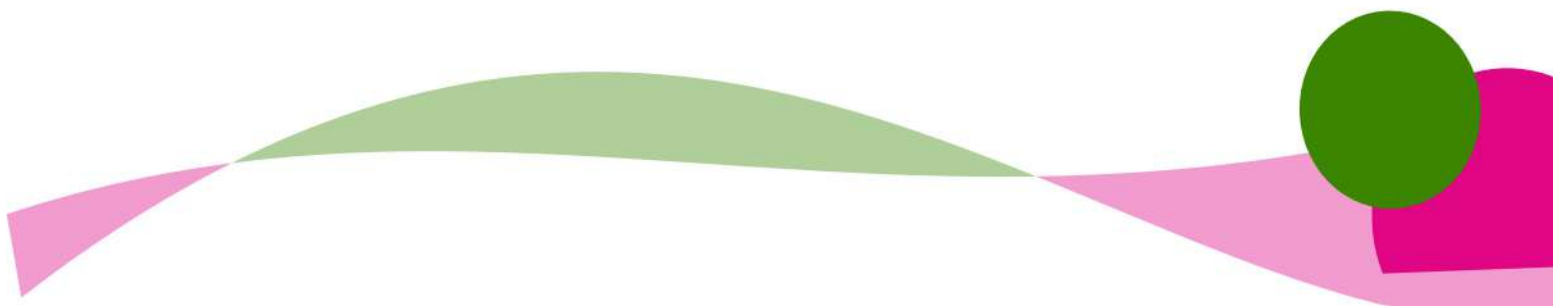

HEALTH AND AWARENESS

Health is an important aspect of our work. We try to promote the health of the communities through divergent approaches. We have S4S Club (*Awareness on self-defense, fitness of the body, healthy food habits, and girl children physical abuse*) and Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM) programme for children and adolescent girls. We conduct awareness generation programmes on cancer, HIV+, irregular menstrual cycle, importance of mother's feeding the infant baby, utilizing healthy sanitary pads for women. We also conduct medical camps, workshops for women where experts in the health areas give awareness to the women. Additionally, we also provide homemade Health Mix – a supplementary nutrition for weak and anemic women and Children.

RESCUE AND REHABILITATION

We have a special infrastructure for our various programmes to rescue and rehabilitate women, children and youth. We provide a Short Stay home, a counseling center, training centre and crèche centers to rehabilitate victimized communities.
