### 3. Programmatic Highlights: Vocational Training

Our primary intervention in FY 2023-24 focused on the **Sewing Machine Operator** course, targeting women aged 18 to 45 in rural and low-income communities. Our unique door-to-door approach ensures that training reaches those who need it most.

We maintained a consistent output, training **30 students per batch**.
